






Animal Alphabet Games Quilt

Size: 591/2" x 661/2"

Quilt designed by J. Wecker Frisch Skill level – Advanced Beginner

Cutting:

21000 S Fussy cut panel into a rectangle 32" x 39".

21001 H Fussy cut four rectangular strips 7½" x 58". (Extra length allowed for mitered corners)

21131 E Cut eight strips 25%" by width of fabric. Subcut a total of 110 25%" x 25%" squares. Subcut each square into two half square triangles.

21005 J Cut eight strips 25%" by width of fabric. Subcut a total of 110 25%" x 25%" squares. Subcut each square into two half square triangles.

Cut four squares 21/4" x 21/4".

Cut four strips 4" by width of fabric.

Subcut these strips to rectangles 4" x 421/2".

Cut seven strips 21/2" by width of fabric.

21002 S Backing

Construction:

Sew with ¼" seam allowance. Press each seam toward the darker fabric as you sew.

1. Sew 21131 E and 21005 J half square triangles together to form squares. Each square should measure 2½" x 2½". You will have a total of 220 triangle squares.

Border 1

 Referring to diagram below, sew 22 triangle squares in the order shown (make two of these).



Placing the light side toward the panel, sew strips to sides of panel.

Referring to diagrams below sew 40 triangle squares in the order shown to make two strips of 20 each.



Placing the light side toward the panel, sew strips to top and bottom of panel.

Quilt center should now measure 35½" x 42½".

Border 2

 Sew 21005 J 4" x 42½" strips to sides of quilt center. Sew 21005 J 4" x 42½" strips to top and bottom of quilt center.

Quilt center should now measure 421/2" x 491/2".

Border 3

- Sew 21001 H 7½" x 58" rectangles to sides of quilt center; aligning top right and bottom left edges and stopping sewing ½" from bottom right and top left ends (border rectangle will extend beyond end of quilt center).
- 2. Sew 21001 H 7½" x 58" rectangles to top and bottom of quilt center; aligning top right and bottom left edges and stopping sewing ¼" from top left and bottom right ends (border rectangle will extend beyond end of quilt center).
- Miter top left and bottom right corners. Trim excess border fabric.

Quilt center should now measure 561/2" x 631/2".

Border 4

1. Referring to diagram below (diagram shows arrangement of blocks), sew two borders each containing 32 triangle squares and two borders each containing 36 triangle squares.



Sew the 36 triangle square borders to the sides of the quilt center; dark side toward center. Sew the four 21005 J 21/4" x 21/4" squares to each end of the other two borders. Sew these borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center; dark side toward center.

Quilt center should now measure 591/2" x 661/2".

Layer and quilt as desired.

Binding:

Sew ends of 21005 J 2½" strips together diagonally. Fold assembled strip in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to right side of quilt, mitering corners. Turn binding to the back of the quilt and slipstitch in place.
