Skill Level: Intermediate

Block Size: 12" Pieced blocks; Picture panels 12" x 21"

Cutting:

*WOF- width of the fabric, from selvage to selvage

20941-SB cut four 12½" x 21½" fussy cut picture panels.

20943-R Select eight pictures for block appliqué, Fussy cut and appliqué using your favorite method

20944-A cut 2 strips, 12½" x WOF, sub cut 4 - 2½" squares.

21075-A cut 4 strips, 4⅞" x WOF, sub cut 32 - 4⅞" squares. Cut each square diagonally for 64 triangles Cut 1 strip, 4½" x WOF, sub cut 8 - 4½" squares Cut 11 strips, 2½" x WOF for binding

20945-KG cut 1 strip, 8⅞" x WOF, sub cut 2 - 8⅞" squares, cut diagonally for 4 triangles Cut 2 strips, 4½" x WOF, sub cut strips 16 - 4½" squares.

20946-R cut 2 strips, 8½" x WOF, sub cut 8 - 8½" squares.

Cut 2 strips, 4½" x WOF, sub cut 16 - 4½" squares.

Cut 8 strips, 2½" x WOF.

21075-S cut 3 strips, 2" x WOF, sub cut 8 - 2" x 12½" rectangles.

Cut 8 strips, 2½" x WOF.

Cut 5 strips, 4⅞" x WOF, sub cut 40 - 4⅞" squares. Cut each square diagonally for 80 triangles.

21074-FA Cut 8 strips, 3½" x WOF for the inner border.

Cut 2 strips, 4½" x WOF, sub cut 16 - 4½" squares.

Cut 1 strip, 8⅞" x WOF, sub cut 2 - 8⅞" squares. Place squares wrong sides together, with the direction of the trees horizontal. Cut diagonally from the lower right to upper left.

20942-GA Cut 4 - 8½" x WOF for the top and bottom borders.

Cut 2 strips 8½" x 94½" on the lengthwise grain for the outer side borders.

20947-B Cut 2 lengths of fabric, 40½" x 100½" and set aside. From remaining fabric, cut two 20½" x 50½" lengths for center of backing strips.

Block assembly:

All seam allowances are ¼"

Picture panel Blocks: Sew a gold 2" x 12½" strip to opposite ends of each picture panel. Press seams toward the strip.

Corner, Octagon blocks:

Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of 16 - 4½" red squares.

Place a red square, right sides together, on one corner of a 12½" brown deer square. Sew on the marked line.

Trim the outer corner, leaving a ¼" seam. Fold over and press toward corner. Repeat for each remaining corners of the square. Repeat to make 4 blocks.



Pieced blocks with appliqué:

A. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 4½" brown square. Place a brown square on one corner of an 8½" red square. Sew on the marked line. Trim the outer corner, leaving a ¼" seam. Fold over and press toward corner. Repeat to make 8 squares.

B. Sew a gold triangle to a print square to make a left and right pair of each as shown below. Make 8 pairs.

C. Sew these to opposite sides of red square, as shown.

D. Sew a print triangle to four of the pieced blocks. Refer to the center of the quilt illustration for sewing the tree triangles to the remaining 4 blocks. Make a total of 8 blocks.

Appliqué the deer images to the pieced blocks. Refer to the quilt illustration for placement.





Churn Dash blocks:

- Sew 2½" red and gold strips together. Make 8 strips sets. Press seams open
- Cut 64 - 4½ units from strip sets
- Sew gold and brown triangles together. Make 64 gold and brown half square triangle units.
- Refer to block diagram for row arrangement and sew the rows together to complete the blocks.
Make 16 pieced blocks.



Quilt Assembly:

Arrange and sew the blocks into rows. Refer to quilt image for placement.

Inner Borders:

Sew 3½" tree border strips into one long strip. Cut two strips, 3½" x 72½" top and bottom borders.

Cut two strips 3½" x 78½" for side borders.

Sew top on bottom borders to quilt center. Sew a border strips to opposite side of quilt center.

Press seams toward border strip.

Outer Borders:

Sew 8½" x WOF border strips into one long strip. Cut two strips, 8½" x 78½". Sew to the top and bottom of quilt top.

Sew 8½" x 94½" border strips to opposite sides of quilt top. Press seams toward border strip.

Sew backing pieces together to make a 100½" square, as shown below. Layer, quilt and bind.
