





Let's Go Camping

Quilt design by Kate Mitchell Quilts Approximate Finished size: 56½" x 68½"

Skill Level: Advanced

Block Size: Paper pieced Crossed Canoes - 12"

Fusible Applique Pup tent 12" x 10"

Note: All seams 1/4" unless otherwise specified

21144 G stripe – Cut $4 - 8\frac{1}{2}$ " strips lengthwise, then sub cut $2 - 8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and $2 - 8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 57" strips.

21145 R red stars – Cut $7 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips (binding). Cut 5 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, join and sub cut $4 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and $2 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52½" strips. Cut 1 - 3" strip, sub cut 12 - 3" squares

21145 B It. blue stars – Cut 5 – 9" strips, sub cut 48 – 4" x 9" rectangles

21293 S yellow swirls - cut 1-9" strip, sub cut 12 - 3" x 9" rectangles 21145 GA plaid – reserve for appliqué

21281 Y scenic - backing - cut 2 lengths - 11/8 yards long. Sew these together along the selvedge using a 1" seam allowance. Trim seam allowance to 1/2" and press to one side.

Crossed Canoe Blocks Step 1 -Yellow Canoe Blocks

You will need: 12 – 3" x 9" rectangles yellow swirl 24 – 4" x 9" rectangles It. blue with stars 12 – 3" x 3" squares dk. blue swirls

Stitch components in order indicated on foundation paper. Fabric placement is labeled on foundation paper. You will need to make 24 copies of the foundation.

Step 2 – Blue Canoe Blocks

You will need: 12 - 3" x 9" rectangles dk blue swirl 24 – 4" x 9" rectangles It. blue with stars 12 - 3" x 3" squares red with stars

Repeat Step 1, substituting the Dark Blue Swirl for the Yellow Swirl and the Red with Stars as the small triangles.


Step 3 - Join Canoe Blocks

You will need: 12 - Yellow Canoe Blocks from step 1 and 12 Blue Canoe blocks from step 2

Stitch Canoe blocks together, alternating colors, as shown below. Press in direction indicated by arrows. Make 6 blocks.

Step 4 - Form Center of Quilt

Stitch the Canoe blocks together into 2 rows, with 3 rows in each row.



Step 5 - Pup Tent Blocks

You will need: $6 - 10\frac{1}{2}$ x $12\frac{1}{2}$ rectangles dk. blue swirl

1/4 yard red with stars

1/4 yard yellow swirls

1/2 yard plaid

Fusible web

Trace the tent motifs onto the paper side of the fusible. Press fusible web onto the wrong side of the fabric, following manufacturer's instructions. After fusing, cut out motifs on the drawn line, press to the right side of the background fabric, centering the shape on the background. Stitch around the tents, using a satin stitch to finish the block. Make 6.



Stitch into 2 rows of three tents each

Step 6 - Assemble Quilt - refer to guilt image

You will need: Canoe Block Center

2 - Tent Rows

 $7 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips red with stars $2 - 8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52½" border stripe strips

 $2 - 8\frac{1}{2} \times 57$ " border stripe strips


Stitch a 2½" x 36½" red strip to top and bottom of the Canoe Block center. Attach a Tent Row to the top and bottom, and follow with another 2½" x 36½" red strip, as shown in quilt picture.

Stitch a 2½" x 52½" strip to either side of the guilt center.

Attach outer borders. You will need 2 border strips that measure 81/2" x 521/2" for the sides and 2 border strips that measure 8½" x 57" for the top and bottom.

Press carefully. Layer, baste and guilt as desired.
