

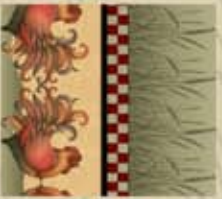

Skill level: Beginner

Cutting

45215 J (Black Roosters) – ½ yard

Cut (5) 2½" x Width of Fabric (WOF), Miter short end together. Subcut (2) 2½" x 47½" and (2) 2½" x 53½"

45216A (Beige Roosters) – ½ yard

Cut (2) 5½" x WOF, Subcut (2) 5½" x 41⅜"

45217 R (Border Print) – 2⅓ yards

Fussy cut (4) 5½" x 80" strips, following the Border Stripe. Make all pieces the same.

45218 H (Green Tonal) – 4½ yards

Subcut (2) 2 yard pieces. With right sides together, sew one long selvedge edge with a 1" seam allowance. Trim seam to ½" and press open. Backing

45220 R- ⅝ yard Cut (7) 2½" x WOF, Miter short ends together making one long strip. Press strip in half wrong sides together. Binding

45214 R (Rooster Panel) – 2 Panels

Fussy cut (2) Panels together, making (1) square 41⅜" x 43½". Center the images.

Note: All seams are sewn with a ¼" seam allowance. All seams are pressed towards the dark fabric unless otherwise stated.

Sewing Directions

Sew the Beige Rooster 5½" x 41⅜" to the top and bottom of the Fussy Cut Rooster Panel. Quilt Center

Sew the Black Rooster 2½" x 53½" to the left and right side of the Quilt Center.

Sew the Black Rooster 2½" x 47½" to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center

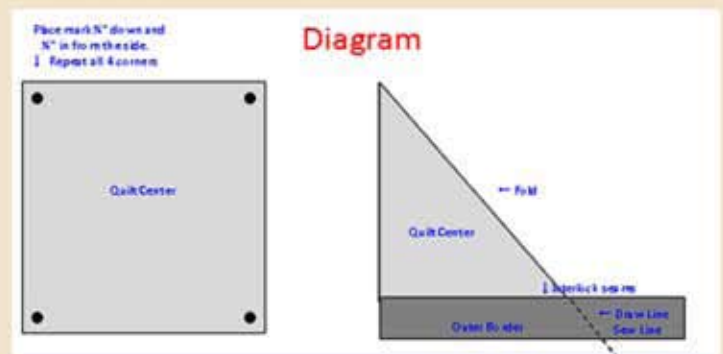
Sew the Border Print 6⅛" x 80" to each side of the Quilt Center following the directions below.

Mitered Borders:

On the wrong side of the Quilt Center, place a ¼" mark in each corner. Find the center of the (4) Border Strips, mark with a pin on the side that will be sewn to the Quilt Center. Find the center of all four sides of the Quilt Center, mark with a pin. Measure the Quilt Center top and bottom, divide this measurement in half. Place a pin at the measurement in both directions from the center pin on 2 of the Border Strips. Attach the Border Strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center, matching the center pins. The remaining (2) pins should match the outside edge of the Quilt Center. Sew the Border Strip starting at ¼" corner mark and ending at the ¼" corner mark. Leave long thread tails, do not knot or use reverse sewing. DO NOT trim the extra fabric. Repeat on the left and right side of the Quilt Center. Diagram

With right sides together fold the quilt in half on the diagonal. Your extra Border Strip fabric should extend to the right. Line up the bottom Border Strip fabric edges and interlock the Border Strip seams, pin in place. Match the horizontal strip of the Outer Border fabric, pin in place. Draw a line extending the diagonal fold through the Border Strip. This drawn line will be your sew line.

Sew on drawn line, leaving long thread tails, open quilt to make sure that the intersection lays flat. Tie off thread tails. Cut away excess fabric, press seam open. Repeat on remaining (3) corners.



Layer, quilt as desired and bind.
