



IMPORTANT NOTE: When printing paper piecing templates be sure page scaling is set to none or no scaling.

Cutting Instructions; WOF = width of fabric
As you sub cut the pieces for each strip, place them
in a plastic zip lock bag and use a permanent
marker to note on the outside of the bag what part
of the quilt they are for (block and/or border), their
quantity, cut size and if applicable their paper piecing location, for example(C5).

Fabric A- Yellow Print:

Texas Flower blocks, row 1:

Cut 1 strip @ 4 ½" x WOF. Sub cut 6 squares @ 4 ½" x 4 ½" (C5)

Cut 1 strip @ 2 ¾" x WOF. Sub cut 6 squares @ 2 ¾" x 2 ¾", divide the squares diagonally to make 12 triangles. (A2, A4)

Cut 2 strips @ 4 ¾" x WOF. Sub cut 12 squares @ 4 ¾" x 4 ¾", divide the squares diagonally to make 24 triangles. (B2, B3) (C2, C3).

Cow paper pieced blocks, rows 2 & 7:

Cut 1 strip @ 7 1/4" x WOF. Sub cut 3 rectangles @ 6 3/4" x 7 1/4" (A1) cow body.

Cut 1 strip @ 4 ¼" x WOF. Sub cut 6 rectangles @ 2 ¾" x 4 ¼" (E2, E4) legs. Sub cut 3 rectangles @ 2 ¾" x 4 ¼" (B4) heads.

Cut 1 strip @ 2 ½" x WOF. Sub cut 3 rectangles @ 2 ½" x 4 ¼" (D2). Sub cut 3 rectangles @ 1 ¾" x 2 ½" (C3).

Fabric B- Blue Print:

Row 6

Cut 2 strips 5 1/2" x WOF.

Texas Flower paper pieced blocks, row 1 Cut 2 @ strips 4 ¾" x WOF. Sub cut 12 squares @ 4 ¾" x 4 ¾", divide the squares diagonally to make 24 triangles. (B1, B4), (C1, C4):

Fabric C- Blue Tonal:

Outer Border;

Cut 8 strips @ 2 ½" x WOF. Join the strips along the narrow edge using a diagonal seam.

Cow paper pieced blocks, rows 2 & 7:

Cut 1 strip @ 2 1/4" x WOF. Sub cut 7 rectangles @ 2 1/4" x 3", divide the squares diagonally to make 14 triangles (C2), (B1) Cut 7 tail appliqués Fence blocks, row 4:

Cut 2 strips @ 2 ½" x WOF. Sub cut 18 squares @ 2 ½" x 2 ½".

Cut 1 strip @ 1 ½" x WOF; Sub cut 24 squares @ 1 ½" x 1 ½"

Fabric D- Border Print:

Rows 2 & 8:

Fussy cut 4 strips @ 10 ½" x WOF; Sub cut 4 rectangles @ 10 ½" x 25 ½".

Fabric E- Blue Check:

Flower appliqué blocks, rows 3 & 8: Cut 2 strips @ 10 ½" x WOF. Sub cut 4 squares @ 10 ½" x 10 ½".

Fabric F- Pink Print: Fence blocks, row 4:

Cut 2 strips @ 4 1/2" x WOF. Sub cut 18 rectangles @ 2 1/2" x 4 1/2".

Fabric G-Large Print: Row 5:

Cut 2 strips @ 10 1/2" x WOF. Sub cut 4 squares @ 10 1/2" x 10 1/2"

Fabric H- Green Check:

Texas Flower paper pieced blocks, row 1:

Cut 1 strip @ 11" x WOF. Sub cut 6 rectangles @ 2"

x 11" (A6). Sub cut 6 rectangles @ 3 1/8" x 5" (A1).

Cut 1 strip @ 2 3/4" x WOF. Sub cut 6 squares @ 2

3/4" x 2 3/4", divide the squares diagonally to make 12 triangles. (A3, A5).

Cow paper pieced block, rows 2 & 7:

Cut 1 strip @ 2 ½" x WOF. Sub cut 7 rectangles @ 1 ¾" x 2 ½" (B3)

Cut 2 strips @ 4 1/4" x WOF. Sub cut 7 rectangles @ 3" x 4 1/4" (D1). Sub cut 7 rectangles @ 3" x 4 1/4" (E3).

Fabric H- Green Check continued)

Flower appliqué blocks, rows 3 & 8: Cut 1 strip @ 10 ½" x WOF. Sub cut 3 squares @ 10 ½" x 10 ½".

Checkerboard block, row 5: Cut 2 strips 2 ½" x WOF.

Fabric I- Pink Tonal:

Inner Border and binding;

Cut 8 strips @ 1 1/2" x WOF for the border.

Cut 8 strips @ 2 ½" x WOF for binding. Join the strips along the narrow edge using a diagonal seam

Texas Flower paper pieced blocks, row 1:

Cut 1 @ strips 8 ½" x WOF. Sub cut 3 squares @ 8 ½" x 8 ½", divide the squares diagonally to make 6 triangles. (A7)

Cow paper pieced block, rows 2 & 7:

Cut 1 strip @ 6 3/4" x WOF. Sub cut 4 rectangles @ 6 3/4" x 7 1/4" (A1) cow body.

Cut 1 strip @ 4 1/4" x WOF. Sub cut 8 rectangles

@ 2"x 4 1/4" (E2, E4) legs. Sub cut 4 rectangles

@ 2 3/4" x 4 1/4" (B4) heads.

Cut 1 strip @ 2 1/2" x WOF. Sub cut 4 rectangles

@ 2 1/2" x 4" (D2). Sub cut 4 rectangles

@ 1 3/4" x 2 1/2" (C3).

Flower appliqué blocks, rows 3 & 8:

Cut 5 strips @ 5" x WOF. Cut (63) templates J

Checkerboard block, row 5: Cut 2 strips 2 ½" x WOF.

Fabric J- Beige Tonal: Cow paper pieced block, rows 2 & 7:

Cut 1 strip @ 2 1/4" x WOF. Sub cut 7 rectangles @ 2 1/4" x 3", divide the squares diagonally to make 14 triangles (C1), (B2)

Fabric K- Brown Print: Flower appliqué blocks, rows 3 & 8:

Cut 1 strip @ 3 1/2" x WOF. Cut (7) templates K

Fabric L- Yellow Tonal: Fence blocks, row 4: Cut 1 strip @ 10 ½" x WOF. Sub cut 12 rectangles @ 2 ½" x 10 ½".

Cut 1 strip @ 2 ½" x WOF. Sub cut 36 rectangles @ 1 ½" x 2 ½".

Fabric M- Green Print: Fence blocks, row 4: Cut 2 strips @ 2 ½" x WOF. Sub cut 18 squares @ 2 ½" x 2 ½".

Assembling the Quilt Units





Texas Flower blocks, row 1: Paper piece blocks using foundation sheet provided.

Pieces needed for this block

Fabric A- Yellow Print: 6 squares @ 4 ½" x 4 ½" (C5), 12 triangles (A2, A4), 24 triangles. (B2, B3) (C2, C3)

Fabric B- Blue Print: 24 triangles. (B1, B4), (C1, C4)

Fabric I- Pink Tonal: 6 triangles. (A7)

Fabric H- Green Check: 6 rectangles @ 2" x 11" (A6), 6 rectangles @ 3 1/8" x 5" (A1), 12 triangles. (A3, A5).

- Use your favorite paper piecing method to create each subunit; A, B & C.
- Attach unit B to the top of unit A. Now attach unit C to the right side of unit A/B, as shown in the image above. Make 6 blocks. Set Aside.



Cow paper pieced block, rows 2 & 7: Paper piece blocks using foundation sheets provided.

Pieces needed for this block

Fabric I- Pink Tonal: 4 rectangles @ 6 ¾" x 7 ¼" (A1) cow body, 8 rectangles @ 2" x 4 ¼" (E2, E4) legs, 4 rectangles @ 2 ¾" x 4 ¼" (B4) heads, 4 rectangles @ 2 ½" x 4 ¼" (D2), 4 rectangles @ 1 ¾" x 2 ½" (C3)

Fabric H- Green Check: 7 rectangles @ 1 ¾" x 2 ½" (B3), 7 rectangles @ 3" x 4 ¼" (D1), 7 rectangles @ 3" x 4 ¼" (E3), 7 rectangles @ 6" x 4 ¼" (E1) Fabric A-Yellow Print: 3 rectangles @ 6 ¾" x 7 ¼" (A1) cow body, 6 rectangles @ 2" x 4 ¼" (E2, E4) legs, 3 rectangles @ 2 ¾" x 4 ¼" (B4) heads, 3 rectangles @ 2 ¾ " x 4 ¼" (D2), 3 rectangles @ 1 ¾" x 2 ½" (C3).

Cow Blocks continued -

Fabric C- Blue Tonal: 14 triangles (C2), (B1), 7 tail appliqués


Fabric J- Beige Tonal: 14 triangles (C1), (B2)

There are right cow and left cow pattern sheets.

Make 1 pink and 3 yellow cows facing right, and 3 pink cows facing left, making a total of 7 cow blocks. Remember that the images are reversed.

- Use your favorite paper piecing method to create each subunit; A, B, C, D & E.
- 2. Attach unit B to the side of unit C. Now attach unit D to the bottom of unit B/C. Next attach unit A to the side of unit B/C/D. Finally attach unit E to the bottom of unit A/B/C/D. Make 7 blocks.

After all paper piecing is completed, add the appliqué tails using your favorite method. Add small black buttons for eyes. Set aside.





Flower appliqué blocks, rows 3 & 8:

Pieces needed for this block

Fabric H- Green Check: 3 squares @ 10 ½" x 10 ½".

Fabric E- Blue Check: 4 squares @ 10 ½" x 10 ½". Fabric K- Brown Print: 7 flower centers, templates K Fabric I- Pink Tonal: 63 flower petals, templates J Using your favorite appliqué method, arrange and sew 9 Pink Tonal petals around 1 Brown Print center on a Green Check 10 ½" x 10 ½" square. Repeat to make 3 Green Check and 4 Blue Check 10 ½" x 10 ½" squares for a total of 7 flower blocks. Set aside.



Fence blocks, row 4:

Pieces needed for this block

Fabric L- Yellow Tonal: 12 rectangles @ 2 ½" x 10 ½", 36 rectangles @ 1 ½" x 2 ½".

Fabric C- Blue Tonal: 8 squares @ 2 ½" x 2 ½", 24 squares @ 1 ½" x 1 ½"

Fabric M- Green Print: 18 squares @ 2 ½" x 2 ½". Fabric F- Pink Print: 18 rectangles @ 2 ½" x 4 ½".

- 1. Sew a Yellow Tonal 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangle to one side of all Blue Tonal and also to the side of all the Green Print 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares. Press the seam away from the Yellow Tonal.
- 2. Sew a Blue/ Yellow Tonal unit to the end of a Pink Print 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle, and a Yellow / Green Print unit to the other end of the Pink Print 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle, as shown below. Press away from the yellow. Make 18 pieces; these will be unit #1.

3. Draw a diagonal line on each Blue Tonal 1 ½" x 1 ½" square, place on the top left corner of a Yellow Tonal 2 ½" x 10 ½" rectangle. Sew on the diagonal line, trim the seam and press to corner. Figure 1. Repeat with top right corner. Figure 2. Make 12 pieces; these will be unit #2.





4.Sew long sides together joining 3 of the #1 units and 2 of the #2 units, as shown below to complete a fence block. Repeat to make 6 fence blocks.









Checkerboard block, row 5:

Pieces needed for this block

Fabric H- Green Check: 2 strips 2 ½" x WOF. Fabric I- Pink Tonal: 2 strips 2 ½" x WOF.

- Sew 1 strip each of the Green Check and the Pink Tonal together; press the seam towards the pink tonal. Sub cut 20, 3" wide rectangles from these strips
- Sort out these units into blocks; rotate every other unit as you lay them out. Make sure that the pink squares are in the top left corner and the bottom right.
- 3. Sew the top 2 units together making a 4 patch block, do the same with the bottom 2 units. Sew these 2, 4-patch units together. Repeat to make 5 blocks. These will measure 4 ½" x 10 ½" unfinished. Set aside.

Row Assembly:

Row 1: Sew Texas flower blocks together in pairs, rotating the right block so the base of each block is on the bottom. Make 3 pairs. Sew each pair set together, to complete the row.

Row 2: Sew, the fussy cut Border Print, 10 ½" x 25 ½" rectangles to each side of a right facing pink cow block.

Row 3: Alternating Green Check & Blue Check, flower blocks, sew the blocks together to complete row.

Row 4: Sew together, 6 fence blocks, side by side. Row 5: Sewing from left to right, sew a checker-board block, to a Large Print 10 ½" x 10 ½" square, then another checkerboard block. Continue to add the checkerboard blocks and Large Print squares till the row is completed.

Row 6: Using the 2, Blue Print, 5 ½" x WOF strips, Join the strips along the narrow edge using a diagonal seam. Sub cut 1 strip @ 5 ½" x 60 ½".

Row 7: Sew cow blocks together in pairs. Join 1 each of the Yellow right facing cows with the left facing Pink cow. Sew the block pairs together to complete the row.

Row Assembly continued -


Row 8: Sew the remaining fussy cut Border Print, 10 ½" x 25 ½" rectangles to each side of a Blue Check Daisy block.


Quilt Assembly:


- Sew rows together in order, 1-8 to complete quilt center.
- 2. Inner border: From the long Pink Tonal strip, sub cut 2 strips @ 1 ½" x 75" and sew to sides of quilt.
- 3. Sub cut 2 strips @ 1 ½" x 62" and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press the seams towards the border strip.
- Outer border: From the long Blue Tonal strip, sub cut 2 strips @ 2 ½" x 77" and sew to sides of quilt.
- 5. Sub cut 2 strips @ 2 ½" x 66" and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press the seams towards the border strip.
- 6. Layer quilt, quilt as desired. Bind using the long Pink Tonal 2 ½" strip.

While all possible care has been taken to ensure the accuracy of this pattern, we are not responsible for printing errors or the ways in which individual work varies.


