

Finished Block Size: 7" for Double Wedding Ring Blocks, and 13" for Center Block

Number of Blocks: 20 Double Wedding Ring Blocks and 1 Center Block

**NOTE:** A double wedding ring block consists of 1 center piece, 4 pieced arc pieces, and 4 melon pieces.



*\*This pattern assumes basic knowledge of paper piecing and will involve curve piecing.*

### To Get Started:

Print templates for the appliqué pieces: 8 for dove silhouette and 4 for hearts (half facing right and half facing left); 16 Dresden fan petals for the center block; 20 block center templates; 80 melon templates; and enough copies of the arc paper piecing pattern for 80 arc pieces.

### Cutting:

WOF = width of fabric, selvedge to selvedge.

#### 22289 KZ: White Dots on Gray

- Cut 3 strips @ 7 1/2" x WOF; sub cut 12 block center pieces using the block center template.
- Cut 1 strip @ 6 3/4" x WOF; sub cut 8 petal pieces using the petal template.

#### 21272 KZ: Gray Solid

- Cut 7 strips @ 1" x WOF; from two strips, sub cut 2 strips @ 1" x 13 1/2" and 2 strips @ 1" x 14 1/2" rectangles. Sub cut from 2 more strips, 2 @ 1" x 30 1/2". Join the remaining 3 strips using diagonal seams; sub cut 2 strips @ 1" x 43 1/2".
- Cut 13 strips @ 2" x WOF; sub cut 160 units @ 3" for the large arc pieces.
- Cut 2 strips @ 2" x WOF; sub cut 80 squares @ 2", divide each piece once diagonally for the triangular arc pieces.
- Cut 1 strip @ 6 3/4" x WOF; sub cut 8 petal pieces using the petal template.
- Cut 1 @ 6" x WOF, to be used for cutting the backing of pieced petal pockets for center block.

#### 22288 ZK: Gray Stripe

- Cut 5 strips @ 1" x WOF; sub cut 2 strips @ 1" x 29 1/2". Join the remaining 3 strips using diagonal seams; sub cut 2 strips @ 1" x 42 1/2".
- Cut 13 strips @ 2" x WOF; sub cut 160 units @ 3" for the large arc pieces.
- Cut 2 strips @ 2" x WOF; sub cut 80 squares @ 2", divide each piece once diagonally for the triangular arc pieces.

#### 22282 ZK: Bell Print

- Cut 1 strip @ 5" x WOF; cut enough pieces for 8 dove silhouette appliqué. Note: four of the pieces are in reversed orientation.

#### 22281 KZ: Damask Print

- Cut 5 strips @ 4 1/2" x WOF; sub cut 2 strips @ 4 1/2" x 38 1/2". Join the remaining 3 strips using diagonal seams; sub cut 2 strips @ 4 1/2" x 44 1/2".

### 22284 ZK: Bird Print

- Cut 1 strip @ 13 1/2" x WOF; sub cut 1 square @ 13 1/2" x 13 1/2".
- Cut 1 strip @ 3"; sub cut 4 pieces from the heart template. Note: 2 of the pieces are in reverse orientation.

### 22287 ZK: Scroll Print

- Cut 9 strips @ 2" x WOF; sub cut 80 melon pieces.

### 22286 ZK: Rose Print

- Cut 2 strips @ 7 1/2" x WOF; sub cut 8 block center pieces using the block center template.


### 21272 KZ (Binding): Gray Solid

- Cut 6 strips @ 2 1/2" x WOF; Join the strips using diagonal seams.


**Note:** 1/4" seam allowance unless noted otherwise

#### Center Block Assembly:

1. Piece two gray solid and two white dots on gray petal pieces together to form a quarter-Dresden fan unit. Repeat to make a total of four units.
2. Lay one pieced unit on the gray solid fabric, and cut a gray solid backing piece to match the shape and size of the pieced fan unit. Repeat to cut a total of four backing pieces.
3. Lay one pieced fan unit on one gray solid backing piece, right sides together. Sew around the scalloped edge of the piece with a 1/4" seam allowance, leaving the sides open. Use a very short stitch length; trim and clip curved edges. Turn right side out. Baste the open side seam layers together to complete one pieced fan. Press. Repeat for the remaining the pieced fan units and backing pieces.



4. Baste the straight edges of each pieced fan unit into each corner of the bird print 13 1/2" x 13 1/2" square (see Center Block Diagram, below). Sew through all layers, on the seams of the first and last scallops, as shown with the bold lines below. When the quilt is completed, these pockets can be filled with personal mementos.


5. Embellish center block as desired with information of wedding or anniversary.

#### Double Wedding Ring Block Assembly:


1. Paper piece the arc pieces using the 2" x 3" gray stripe and gray solid fabric pieces for the large arc pieces and the triangles for the end arc pieces. Trim the unit on the outline of the paper piecing pattern. Carefully remove paper from the pieced units. Mark the corners of the seam line on the wrong side of the fabric with a pencil. Make a total of 80 pieced arc units.



2. Fold and mark the center of melon pieces and mark the corners of the seam line on the wrong side of the fabric with a pencil. Pin a pieced arc and a scroll melon piece together with the arc on the curved side of the melon shape. Make sure the centers and corners match. Stitch the pieces together. Press the seams toward the melon shape. Make a total of 80 units.




3. Find the center of a block center unit. Sew two units made in step 2 to the opposite sides of one white dot on gray block center piece, matching the centers. Match the corners of the center unit to the last arc unit (next to the triangle unit) as shown in the detail drawing, below. Start and stop sewing at the seam. Do not trim the thread tails. Pull the tails through to side of the seam and tie a knot with the thread tails. Sew another two units on the remaining opposite sides to complete the block, same as before. Press the seams away from the center.




4. To complete unit, fold the block in half diagonally, right sides together. Start sewing at the seam near the triangle, at the spot where you started or stopped sewing before. Sew to the end of the triangle unit as shown in the detail drawing, below.



5. Repeat to make 12 blocks with white dots on gray for the center of the block, and 8 blocks with the rose print for the center of the block.

12 Blocks**




**Bird print block

6. Prepare the appliqué pieces using the appliqué method of your choice. Appliqué the dove silhouette on eight of the “white dots on gray” blocks. Appliqué a heart on four of the “white dots on gray” blocks (See dove and heart blocks below). Half of the motifs for the blocks should face left and the other half should face right.






### Quilt Center Assembly:

1. Sew two 1" x 13 1/2" gray solid rectangles onto the opposite side of the 13 1/2" center block. Sew two 1" x 14 1/2" gray solid rectangles to the remaining sides of the center block (see the image below).

2. Arrange and sew the blocks together according to Quilt Center Diagram shown below.



6. To round the corners of the quilt, place a dinner plate or salad plate inside each corner and mark the rounded edge.





### Finishing:

1. Sandwich and baste quilt top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired.
2. Bind with the gray solid binding strip.





**For the borders, as each border strip is sewn on, press the seam away from the center.**

3. Inner Border #1. Sew two striped 1" x 42 ½" strips onto the opposite long sides of the quilt center. Sew two striped 1" x 29 ½" strips onto the opposite short sides of the quilt center.
4. Inner Border #2. Sew two gray solid 1" x 43 ½" strips onto the opposite long sides of the quilt center. Sew two gray solid 1" x 30 ½" strips onto the opposite short sides of the quilt center.
5. Outer Border. Sew two 4 ½" x 44 ½" damask strips onto the opposite long sides of the quilt center. Sew two 4 ½" x 38 ½" damask strips onto the opposite short sides of the quilt center to complete the quilt top.


