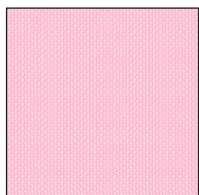

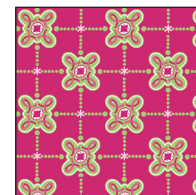

Cutting

Note: Cut all strips across the width of the fabric

22205V Fuchsia Flower Toss

Cut 8 strips $3\frac{3}{8}$ " wide – Subcut to $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " for a total of 24 rectangles.

22208V Fuchsia Medallion Grid

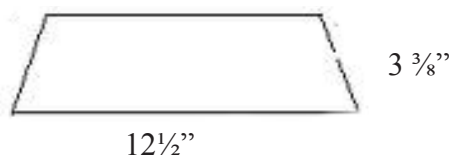
Cut 8 strips $3\frac{3}{8}$ " wide – Subcut to $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " for a total of 24 rectangles.

Cut 7 strips – $1\frac{1}{2}$ " for inner border

22209P Pink Butterfly Toss

Cut 16 strips $3\frac{3}{8}$ " wide – Subcut to $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " for a total of 48 rectangles.

To create a trapezoid from each of the $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles cut from the Fuchsia Flower Toss, Fuchsia Medallion Grid and the Pink Butterfly Toss; trim off the end of each $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " piece at a 45° angle using the 45° marking on an acrylic quilting ruler and rotary cutter. This will create 96 trapezoid pieces.



22206Z Pink Ribbons & Butterflies

Cut 2 strips $4\frac{7}{8}$ " wide- Subcut to $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " for a total of 12 squares. Cut diagonally across each square for a total of 24 half square triangles.

22207G Green Flower Vine

Cut 4 strips $4\frac{7}{8}$ " wide – Subcut to $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " for a total of 24 squares. Cut diagonally across each square for a total of 48 half square triangles.

22211P Lt. Pink Ribbon Blender

Cut 2 strips $4\frac{7}{8}$ " - Subcut $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " for a total of 12 squares. Cut diagonally across each square for a total of 24 half square triangles.

22210H Green Words Blender

Cut 7 strips $4\frac{1}{2}$ " wide for outer border

Cut 7 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide for binding

Sewing :

Assemble 24 A block units and 24 B block units as shown below – square up to $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "



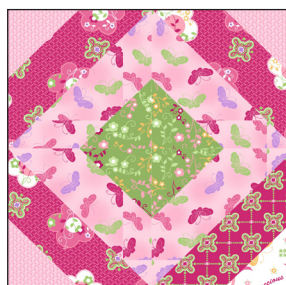
Make 24 - A



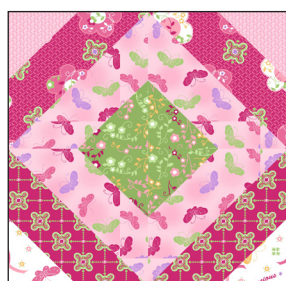
Make 24 - B

Assemble four Blocks 1, six Blocks 2 and two Blocks 3 as shown below, watching placement of fabrics.

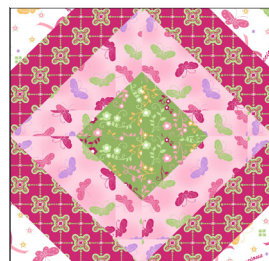
Square blocks to $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ "

uses 3 A units
and 1 B unit



Block 2
Make 6
Each Block 2
uses 2 A units
and 2 B units



Block 3
Make 2
Each Block 3
uses 4 B units

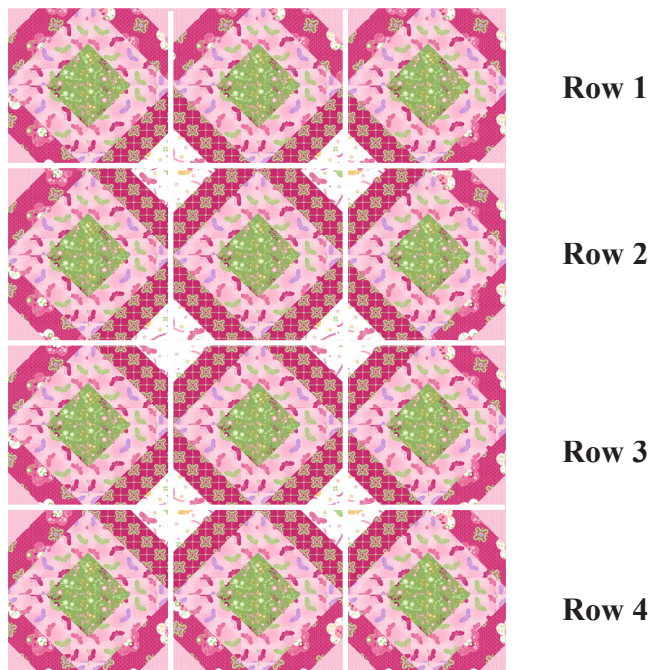
Assemble the Quilt Center

Refer to image below for block orientation and sew Blocks into rows as follows:

Rows 1 and 4: Block 1, Block 2, Block 1

Rows 2 and 3: Block 2, Block 3, Block 2

Sew rows together, referring to image below for proper placement.



Inner Border

Join Fuchsia Medallion 1½”strips together to make one long strip. Measure the length of the quilt top through the center. Cut 2 strips to that measurement and sew to the sides of the top. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center and cut 2 strips to that measurement. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

Outer Border

Join Green Words Blender strips together to make one long strip. Follow steps for inner border to add the Green outer border to the quilt.

Finishing

Layer and quilt as desired. Bind with Green Words Blender strips.
