

ZOO CREW - ALL AROUND THE ARK

Finished Size: 58½" x 67½"

Finished Block: 9" WOF = Width of Fabric

Fabric Cutting Directions

Note: All strips are cut width of fabric, unless otherwise noted. All seams are sewn with a ¹/₄" seam allowance.

22488Q Baby Zoo Crew Panel

• Cut panel $32\frac{1}{2}$ " x $41\frac{1}{2}$ " centering motif within.

22489B Tossed Animals Blue

- Cut (1) 9 1/2" strip; subcut (4) 9 1/2" squares.
- Cut (3) 2 1/4" strips for 9-patch blocks.
- Cut (2) 2 3/8" strips for 9-patch frames.

22489K Tossed Animals Gray

• Cut (1) 9½" strip, subcut (4) 9½" squares.

22490R Flags Banner Red

- Cut (2) 5 3/4" strips. Subcut one strip into (16) 2 3/8" rectangles. Remaining strip will be used in 9-patch frames.
- Cut (4) 2 1/2"; subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 36 1/2" and (2) 2 1/2" x 41 1/2" for inner border.
- Cut (7) 2½" strips for Outer Border. Sew together end to end; press. Cut (2) 2 1/2" x 58 1/2" and (2) 2 1/2" x 63 1/2".

22490S Flags Banner Yellow

• Cut (1) 2 1/4" strip for 9-patch blocks.

22491B Clouds Blender Blue

• Cut (1) 9 1/2" strip; subcut (2) 9 1/2" squares.

22491S Clouds Blender Yellow

- Cut (1) 9 1/2" strip; subcut (4) 9 1/2" squares.
- Cut (2) 2 1/4" strips for 9-patch blocks.

22493X Stripe

• Cut a total of 275" of 2" bias binding.


Construction Directions


Center Panel

1. Sew (D) 2 1/2" x 41 1/2" strip to sides of panel. Sew (D) 2 1/2" x 36 1/2" to top/bottom of panel. Press toward borders.

1. For 9-Patch Blocks:

- **a.** Sew one strip set using 2 1/4" strips of G, B, G. Press toward center (B) strip. (see diagram A).
- **b.** Subcut above strip set into (16) 2 1/4" segments.
- **c.** Sew one strip set using 2 1/4" strips of B, E, B. Press toward outer (B) strips. (see diagram B)
- **d.** Subcut above strip set into (8) 2 1/4" segments.
- e. Lay out segments into rows as shown below. Sew rows together and press. Repeat to complete eight blocks.





While all possible care has been taken to ensure the accuracy of this pattern, we are not responsible for printing errors or the way in which individual work varies.

2. For 9-Patch Frame:

- **a.** Sew one strip set using two (B) 2 3/8" strips and one (D) 5 3/4" strip. Press toward center (D) strip. (see diagram C).
- **b.** Subcut above strip set into (16) 2 3/8" segments.
- **c.** Sew one (D) 2 3/8" x 5 3/4" rectangle to sides of one 9-patch block. Press toward (D) frames.
- **d.** Sew one strip set segment to top/bottom of block. Press toward frames. Repeat to complete eight blocks. (see diagram D).





Assembly

- 1. Referring to quilt image for correct placement, sew three squares and two blocks together for side of panel. Press toward squares. Repeat for other side section. Sew to quilt and press toward inner border.
- 2. Referring to quilt image for correct placement, sew four squares and two blocks together for top/bottom of panel. Press toward outer squares with center seam being pressed in either direction. Repeat. Sew to quilt and press toward inner border.
- **3.** Sew the (D) 2 1/2" x 63 1/2" strips to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the borders. Sew the (D) 2 1/2" x 58 1/2" strips to the top/bottom. Press.

Finishing

- 1. Prepare backing using two widths with horizontal seam. Layer top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired
- **2.** Sew binding to quilt using your preferred method.
