Note: These instructions are used to make either of the 2 color versions of the quilt and runner. Much of the information is the same for either color. Where there are differences, information for the Red/Green version is given first followed by information for the Red/Teal version in parentheses. Label all pieces with the letters given in the cutting list. These letters are used to identify the pieces throughout the instructions and apply to both color versions.
$\mathbf{W O F}=$ width of fabric from selvage to selvage.

## Cutting Directions for Quilt:

22864 E ( 22864 K): Cream Floral (Gray Floral)

- Cut (2) $61 / 2$ " x WOF strips; recut into (10) $61 / 2$ " P squares.


## 22880 EK: Floral Stripe

- Cut (2) $81 / 2$ " $\times 76^{\prime \prime}$ strips along the length of fabric with the large floral stripe centered in each strip.
- Cut (2) $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 68^{\prime \prime}$ strips along the length of fabric with the large floral stripe centered in each strip.
Note: If making matching runner, reserve narrow stripe sections for runner borders.

22868 Q ( $\mathbf{2 2 8 7 2}$ H): Dark Teal Texture (Green Texture)

- Cut (14) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips for borders.
- Cut (7) $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for binding.


## 22869 K: Gray Print

- Cut (2) $93 / 4$ x WOF strips; recut into (5) $93 / 4$ " Q squares and (2) $51 / 8^{\prime \prime} R$ squares. Cut the $Q$ squares twice diagonally to make 18 Q triangles and the R squares in half diagonally to make 4 R triangles. Note: If making runner, cut 2 additional $51 / s^{\prime \prime} R$ squares and cut in half diagonally to make $4 R$ triangles for runner.


## 22881 T: Red Dot

- Cut (4) $2^{1 ⁄ 21}$ " x WOF strips for A.
- Cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips for K.

22867 T: Red Paisley

- Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips for B.
- Cut (1) 1" x WOF strip for $L$.

22869 D: Coral Print

- Cut (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for C; recut (1) strip into (2) 21 "-long C strips.
- Cut (1) $2^{1 ⁄ 21}$ x WOF strip for M; recut into (2) 21 "-long M strips.

22872 T: Coral Texture

- Cut (4) 1" x WOF strips for D; recut (1) strip into (2) 21 "-long D strips.
- Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip for N; recut into (2) 21"-long N strips.

22871 D: Coral Diagonal Plaid

- Cut (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for E; recut (1) strip into (2) 21 "-long E strips.
- Cut (1) $21 / 2$ " x WOF strip for O; recut into (2) 21 "-long O strips.

22881 H (22867 Q): Green Dot (Teal Paisley)

- Cut (5) $2^{1 ⁄ 2}$ " x WOF strips for F; recut (1) strip into (2) 21 "-long F strips.

22872 H (22868 Q): Green Texture (Dark Teal Texture)

- Cut (5) 2" x WOF strips for G; recut (1) strip into (2) 21"-long G strips.

22871 H (22871 Q): Green Diagonal Plaid (Teal Diagonal Plaid)

- Cut (5) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for H; recut (1) strip into (2) 21 "-long H strips.

22869 H ( 22881 Q): Green Print (Teal Dot)

- Cut (5) 1" x WOF strips for I; recut (1) strip into (2) 21 "-long I strips.

22867 E (22872 Q): Cream Paisley (Light Teal Texture)

- Cut (5) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for $J$; recut (1) strip into
(2) $21^{\prime \prime}$-long J strips.


## Backing Fabric

- Cut (2) 71" x WOF strips.


## Stripe Blocks:

Note: Use a $1 / 41$ " seam allowance for all stitching.

1. Sew 1 each full-length A, B, C, D, and E strips lengthwise together to make a strip set. Press seams toward the A strip edge. Repeat to make 3 strip sets total. Crosscut the strip sets into (15) 6½" Red Stripe blocks.

2. Stitch 1 each full-length F, G, H, I, and J strips lengthwise together to make a strip set. Press seams toward the F strip edge. Repeat to make 3 strip sets total. Crosscut the strip sets into (15) $61 / 2$ Green Stripe (Teal Stripe) blocks.


## Woven Blocks:

1. Sew full-length strips lengthwise together in the following order to make a strip set: A, G, K, I, and K. Press seams toward the K strip edge. Crosscut the strip set into (10) $2^{1 / 2} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ segments for quilt and (2) $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ segments for runner.

2. Stitch full-length strips lengthwise together in the following order to make a strip set: F, B, H, L, and J. Press seams toward the F strip edge. Crosscut the strip set into (10) $2^{\prime \prime}$ segments for quilt and (2) $2^{\prime \prime}$ segments for runner.

3. Sew 21 "-long strips lengthwise together in the following order to make a strip set: M, G, C, I, and C. Press seams toward the C strip edge. Crosscut the strip set into (10) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ segments for quilt and (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " segments for runner.

4. Stitch 21 "-long strips lengthwise together in the following order to make a strip set: F, N, H, D, and J. Press seams toward the F strip edge. Crosscut the strip set into (10) 1 " segments for quilt and (2) 1 " segments for runner.

5. Sew 21 "-long strips lengthwise together in the following order to make a strip set: O, G, E, I, and E. Press seams toward the E strip edge. Crosscut the strip set into (10) $1^{1 / 2}$ " segments for quilt and (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " segments for runner.

6. Arrange 1 of each strip segment and join to make (1) $61 / 2$ " x $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Red/Green Woven (Red/Teal Woven) block. Press seams toward the right edge of the block. Repeat to make 10 blocks for quilt and 2 for runner. Note: There will be unused 21 "-long strips.

## Quilt Assembly:

Refer to the quilt center assembly diagram and quilt drawing as needed for the following steps. The Red/Teal quilt center is completed in the same way as shown in the Red/Green quilt center assembly diagram.


Quilt Center Assembly Diagram

1. Arrange the Red Stripe blocks, Green (Teal) Stripe blocks, and 10 Woven blocks together with P squares and Q and R triangles in 10 diagonal rows. Sew into rows. Press all seams toward the Stripe blocks. Join the rows to complete the 43 " x $51^{11 / 2}$ " quilt center. Press seams to 1 side.
2. Sew the $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF dark teal (green) texture strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (4) $76^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (4) $68^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sew the $76^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the long edges of the $76^{\prime \prime}$ floral stripe strips and the $68^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the long edges of the $68^{\prime \prime}$ floral stripe strips to make pieced border strips. Press seams toward the dark teal (green) strips.
3. Center and stitch a 76 " pieced border strip to the long sides of the quilt center, beginning and ending $1 / 4$ " from the corner at each end. Repeat with the $68^{\prime \prime}$ pieced border strips on the top and bottom of the quilt center. Miter corners, carefully matching seams of the borders. Trim corner seam allowance to $1 / 4 /$. Press the corner seam allowances open and the border seams toward the border to complete the quilt top.
4. Remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a $1 / 2$ " seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim the top and bottom edges to make a 71 " x 79" backing piece. The seam will be side to side on the back of the quilt.
5. Layer, quilt, and bind using your favorite methods and the dark teal (green) texture binding strips to complete the quilt.

## Rendezuous: Runner

## Cutting Directions for Runner:

Note: You will need the narrow stripe sections of the floral stripe fabric (22880-EK) and the gray print (22869-K) $R$ triangles that were set aside when cutting the pieces for the quilt. You will also need the 2 extra Woven Blocks made with the blocks for the quilt

22864 E ( $\mathbf{2 2 8 6 4}$ K): Cream Floral (Gray Floral)

- Cut (3) $6^{1 / 2}$ " squares for $P$.

22880 EK: Floral Stripe

- From reserved narrow stripe sections, cut (2) 13/4" x 53" strips and (2) $13 / 4$ " x $19 "$ strips.

22868 Q ( $\mathbf{2 2 8 7 2}$ H): Dark Teal Texture (Green Texture)

- Cut (4) 1" x WOF strips for borders.
- Cut (4) $11 / 2$ " x WOF strips for borders.
- Cut (4) $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips for binding.

22881 T: Red Dot

- Cut (1) $25 / 8$ " x WOF strip for A.


## 22867 T: Red Paisley

- Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip for B.

22872 T: Coral Texture

- Cut (1) 1" x WOF strip for D.

22871 D: Coral Diagonal Plaid

- Cut (1) $13 / 4$ " x WOF strip for E.

22881 H ( 22867 Q): Green Dot (Teal Paisley)

- Cut (1) $25 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip for F.
$\mathbf{2 2 8 7 2}$ H (22868 Q): Green Texture (Dark Teal Texture)
- Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip for G.

22871 H (22871 Q): Green Diagonal Plaid (Teal Diagonal Plaid)

- Cut (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip for H.

22869 H (22881 Q): Green Print (Teal Dot)

- Cut (1) 1" x WOF strip for I.

22867 E (22872 Q): Cream Paisley (Light Teal Texture)

- Cut (1) $13 / 4$ " x WOF strip for J.


## Backing Fabric

-Cut (1) 28" x WOF strip; recut into (2) 21" x 28" pieces.

22869 D: Coral Print

- Cut (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip for C.


## Stripe Triangles:

1. Repeat steps 1 and 2 of Stripe Blocks for Quilt to make 1 red strip set and 1 green or teal strip set. Crosscut each strip set into (2) $67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ segments.

2. Apply a heavy coat of spray starch to each segment and press dry.
3. Cut each segment in half diagonally to make 4 Red Stripe triangles and 4 Green (or Teal) Stripe triangles. Note: The long diagonal bias edge of each triangle will be on the outside edge of the runner center. Handle the triangles with care to avoid stretching.

4. Carefully stitch $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ from the long diagonal edge of each triangle to stabilize.

## Runner Assembly:

Refer to the runner center assembly diagram and runner drawing as needed for the following steps. The Red/Teal runner center is completed in the same way as shown in the Red/Green runner center assembly diagram.


## Runner Center Assembly Diagram

1. Arrange the Red Stripe triangles, Green (or Teal) Stripe triangles, the 2 Woven blocks, and 3 P squares in 5 diagonal rows with the R triangles. Sew into rows. Carefully press all seams away from the Stripe triangles. Join the rows to complete the 9 " x 43" runner center. Press seams to 1 side.
2. Sew the 1" x WOF dark teal (green) texture strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (2) $53 "$ strips and (2) $19 "$ strips. Sew the $53 "$ strips to 1 long edge of each 53 " floral stripe strip and the $19^{\prime \prime}$ strips to 1 long edge of each 19 " floral stripe strip. Press seams toward the dark teal (green) strips. Repeat with the $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF dark teal (green) texture strips to complete the pieced border strips.

## Rendezvous: Runner

3. Center and stitch a 53 " pieced border strip to the long sides of the runner center, beginning and ending $1 / 4 "$ from the corner at each end. Repeat with the 19 " pieced border strips on the short ends of the runner center. Miter corners, carefully matching seams of the borders. Trim corner seam allowance to $1 / 4 /$. Press the corner seam allowances open and the border seams toward the border to complete the quilt top.
4. Join the backing pieces on the short ends with a $1 / 2$ " seam allowance to make a $21^{\prime \prime} \times 55^{\prime \prime}$ backing piece. Press seam open.
5. Layer, quilt, and bind using your favorite methods and the dark teal (green) texture binding strips to complete the runner.
