3. 23031E:

- Cut (4) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (Block A).

4. $23032 \mathrm{~A}-$ Cut as follows:

- Cut (2) strips at 1 " x WOF - Sub-cut into (4) 1" x 19" rectangles (Block A).
- Cut (1) strip at 1" x WOF - Sub-cut into (4) 1" x 9" rectangles (Block A).
-Cut (1) strip 1" x WOF - Sub-cut into (2) 1" x 13" rectangles (Block A).
- Cut (1) strip at $41 / 2$ x WOF - Sub-cut into (36) 1" x 41/2" rectangles - Label A (Outer Border).


## 5. $23032 \mathrm{H}:$

- Cut (2) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ x $13^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.

6. 23032T:

- Cut (2) $21 / 2$ " x $13^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.


## 7. 23032S:

- Cut (2) strips at 2" x WOF - Sub-cut into (2) 2" x 19" rectangles and (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 31^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (Sashing), Cut (4) strips at $1^{1} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF - Sub-cut into (2) $1 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 31$ " (Sides) and (2) $1 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 40^{1} 22^{\prime \prime}$ for the Inner Border.


## 8. 23029 H :

- Cut (6) $4122^{\prime \prime}$ squares - Label C (Outer Border)

19. Sew (1) 23032 S $1^{1 / 4 " ~} \times 31$ " rectangle to each side then sew (1) 23032S $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $40^{1} / 2$ " rectangle to the top and bottom for the Inner Border at $40^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 32^{1 / 2}$ ".

## Outer Border:

Note: When sewing the borders keep in mind the direction of the fabric.
20. Top Border - Sew together as follows from left to right at the $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " edge to measure $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ : A, B, A, C, A, B, A, D, A, B, A, C, A, B, A, E, A, B, A, D --- Sew to the TOP of the CENTER.
21. Bottom Border - Sew together as follows from left to right at the $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " edge to measure $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $40^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ : D, A, B, A, E, A, B, A, C, A, B, A, D, A, B, A, C, A, B, A --Sew to the BOTTOM of the CENTER.
22. Left Side Border - Sew together as follows from left to right at the $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " edge to measure $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $40^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ : E, E, A, B, A, C, A, B, A, D, A, B, A, E, A, B, A, E --- Sew to the LEFT SIDE of the CENTER.
23. Right Side Border - Sew together as follows from left to right at the $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " edge to measure $4 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}: \mathrm{E}, \mathrm{A}$, B, A, E, A, B, A, D, A, B, A, C, A, B, A, E, E --- Sew to the RIGHT SIDE of the CENTER to finish the quilt top at $48^{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Finishing the Placemats:

24. Layer the 23031T backing, batting and quilt top and quilt as desired.
25. Using the 23030ES $2^{1} 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips sew on the binding to finish the placemats.

3. 23028 X :

- Cut (4) 4" squares.


## 4. 23029 S :

- Cut (2) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12$ " rectangles.

5. 23030 A :

- Cut (5) strips at $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF (Binding).

6. 23031 E :

- Cut (1) $12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle - sub-cut into (2) $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, (2) $12^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, and with the balance of the fabric cut (4) $8^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and (4) $31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

7. 23031 T:

- Cut (4) strips at $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} x$ WOF (Border).


## 8. 23032 T:

- Cut (4) 1 " x $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, (8) 1 " x 12 " rectangles, (4) $1 " \times 8$ " rectangles, and (4) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " rectangles.


## 9. 23032 H :

- Cut (4) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, (5) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 14 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, Cut (2) $1^{\prime \prime}$ x 59" rectangles from one of the SELVAGE EDGES as this will use the excess of the backing fabric (Sashing and Inner Border).

10. Sew the following together at the $8 "$ edge from top to bottom to measure 8 " x 12": (1) 23027T 8 " square, (1) 23032T 1" x 8" rectangle, (1) 23031E 4" x 8" rectangle as shown in Example A - Make (4) - set aside (2) for use in Block B - Set A.
11. Sew the following together at the 4 " edge from top to bottom to measure 4" x 12": (1) 23027S 4" x 8" rectangle, (1) 23032T 4" x 1" rectangle, (1) 23028X 4" square as shown in Example B - Make (4) - set aside (2) for use in Block B.
12. Sew (1) 23032T 1" $\times 12$ " rectangle to the LEFT side of the rectangle just sewn - Make (2) - Set B.
13. Sew (1) $23029 \mathrm{~S} 2^{1 / 2} \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to (1) $23032 \mathrm{~T} 1^{\prime \prime}$ x 12 " rectangle - Make (2) - Set C.
14. Sew (1) of Set A and Set B together at the 12" edge with Set A towards the LEFT then sew on Set C to the FAR LEFT to measure $14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12$ ".
15. Sew (1) $23032 \mathrm{H} 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ edge of (1) 23031E $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle - Make (2) then sew (1) 23032T 1" x $14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the bottom $14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ edge with the $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square towards the LEFT.
16. Sew the piece just completed to the top of the $141 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ $12^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle sewn in Instruction No. 14 to finish the block at $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " square - Make (2).


Block B - Make (2):
Note: Refer to the Finished Block as an additional guide.
17. Sew (1) 23032T 1" x 12" rectangle to the LEFT side of the ROTATED which was set aside from Instruction No. 11 - Make (2) - Set B.
18. Sew (1) $23031 \mathrm{E} 2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12$ " rectangle to (1) 23032 T 1 " x 12" rectangle - Make (2) - Set C.
19. Sew (1) of Set A (ROTATED) and Set B (ROTATED) together at the 12" edge with Set A towards the LEFT then sew on Set C to the BOTTOM to measure 12" x $14^{1 / 2}$ ".
20. Sew (1) $23032 \mathrm{H} 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to one $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ edge of (1) 23031E $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 12^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangle - Make (2) then sew (1) 23032T 1" x $14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the right $14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ edge with the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square towards the BOTTOM.
21. Sew the piece just completed to the left of the 12 " x $14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle sewn in Instruction No. 19 to finish the block at $14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square - Make (2).

## Sewing the Tablerunner Center and Borders:

Note: Refer to the cover picture as an additional guide.
22. Sew the center together as follows from left to right to measure $14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 59$ ": $23032 \mathrm{H} 1 " \mathrm{x} 14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$, Block A, 23032H 1" x 1412", Block B, 23032 H 1 " x 1412", Block B ROTATED TWICE, 23032H 1" x 14-1/2", Block A ROTATED TWICE, 23032H 1" x 14-1⁄2".
23. Sew (1) 23032 H 1 " $x 59$ " rectangle to the top and bottom to finish the center along with the Inner Border at $15^{1 / 2 "} \times 59$ ".
24. Using the 23031T $3^{11 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips sew them together at the $31 / 4$ edge to make a long strip then sub-cut into (2) $31 / 4 " \times 15^{1 / 2} "$ rectangles (Sides) and (2) $3^{11 / 4} \times 59 "$ rectangles (Top/Bottom).
25. Sew on the Top and Bottom to the Tablerunner.
26. Sew (1) $23031 \mathrm{E} 31 / 4$ " squares to each $31 / 4$ " edge of the 23031T $3^{1 / 4 " ~ x ~} 151 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to measure $3^{1 / 4}$ " x 21 " - Make (2) then sew onto each side to finish the Tablerunner at 21" x 6412".

## Finishing the Table Runner:

27. Layer the "Tins" 23031H backing, batting and Tablerunner top and quilt as desired.
28. Using the $23030 \mathrm{~A} 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips sew on the binding to finish the Tablerunner.

- Cut (4) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.

4. 23032 A : Cut as follows:
-(4) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2$ " rectangles,
-(4) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, and
-(2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 201 / 2$ " rectangles.
5. $23032 \mathrm{H}:$

- Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $20^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.

## Sewing the Placemat Front:

8. Sew the following together from left to right at the $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " edge to make the center of the placemat at $18^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ ---- (1) 23031E 5" x 8½" rectangle, (1) 23032A 1" x $8^{1} / 2$ " rectangle, Jars $81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ square, (1) 23032A 1 " x $81 / 2 "$ rectangle, (1) 23031E 5" x $81 / 2$ " rectangle - Make (2) as shown in Example A.
9. Sew (1) 23032A $1^{\prime \prime} \times 18 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top and bottom to measure $18 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $9^{1 / 2}$ " - Make (2).
10. Sew the following together from left to right to make a new strip at $5^{1 / 2 "} \times 20^{1 / 2 "}$----- (1) $23032 \mathrm{H} 2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, (1) 23032A 1", (1) 23032T $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, (1) 23032A 1" - Sub-cut into (8) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
11. Sew (1) of the rectangles just completed to each $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ edge of (1) $23029 \mathrm{H} 8 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to make a new rectangle at $18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}-$ Make (2) as shown in Example B.
12. Sew (1) of the rectangles just completed to the top and bottom of the rectangle sewn in Instruction No. 9 to finish the FRONT of the placemat at $18 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $13^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ - Make (2).

## Finishing the Placemats:

13. Layer the "Tins" \#23026A backing, batting and quilt top and quilt as desired.
14. Using the 23030 ES $2^{1} / 2$ " strips sew on the binding to finish the placemats.
