## Cutting Directions:

Note: WOF = width of fabric. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance throughout unless otherwise directed. Label all pieces with the letters given in the cutting list. These letters are used to identify the pieces throughout the instructions.

## 22968 Z: Ballerina Print (Directional Print)

- Cut (2) $12^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. Recut strips into (8) $91 / 2 \mathrm{x} \mathrm{x}$ 123/4" I rectangles.
- Cut (1) 16 " x WOF strip. Recut strip into (4) $9^{1 ⁄ 2} 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{\prime \prime}$ H 2 rectangles
- Cut (9) 5" x WOF Q/R border strips.


## 22972 Z: White Heart Tonal

- Cut (3) $9^{1} / 2$ " x WOF strips. Recut strips into (30) $3^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ 91/2" F strips.
- Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips. Recut strips into (16) 2" x 9½" J strips.
- Cut (12) $21 / 2$ x x WOF strips. Recut strips into (96) $2^{1} 12^{\prime \prime}$ B/E squares ( 48 for B and 48 for E ) and (48) $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "$ C rectangles.
-Cut (7) 2" x WOF K/L border strips.


## 22971 L: Purple Tonal

- Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip. Recut strip into (3) 2" x 9½" G3 strips.
- Cut (2) $2^{1 ⁄ 2} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ W WOF strips. Recut strips into (32) $2^{1 ⁄ 2}$ " D3 squares.


## 22969 Z: White Floral

-Cut (2) 16 " x WOF strips. Recut strips into (8) $91 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ 16" H1 strips.

- Cut (2) $41 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Recut strips into (12) $41 ⁄ 2$ " A squares.


## 22971 B: Blue Tonal

- Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip. Recut strip into (7) 2" x 9½" G1 rectangles.
- Cut (2) $21 / 2$ x WOF strips. Recut strips into (32) $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ D1 squares.


## 22970 P: Pink Print

- Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Recut strips into (5) 2" x 9¹⁄2" G2 strips.
- Cut (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. Recut strips into (32) $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ D2 squares.
- Cut (8) $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF M/N border strips.


## 22971 S: Yellow Tonal

- Cut (8) $11 / 2$ x x WOF P/Q border strips.


## 22971 L: Purple Tonal

- Cut (9) $2 ¼^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF binding strips.

22972 ZP: White/Pink Heart Print

- Cut (3) 86" x WOF strips for backing.


## Completing the Star Blocks:

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each B, D1, D2 and D3 squares.

2. Select an A square and four B squares. Referring to Diagram 1, place a B square right sides together on 1 corner of A and stitch on the marked line. Trim seam to $1 / 4$ " and press B to the right side.
3. Repeat step 2 with a B square on the opposite corner of A , and then on each of the remaining corners to complete an A-B unit, again referring to Diagram 1.
4. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to complete a total of 12 A-B units.

5. Select 1 C rectangle and 2 D1 squares. Referring to Diagram 2, place a D1 square right sides together on 1 corner of C and stitch on the marked line. Trim $1 / 4 /$ from the stitched line and press D1 to the right side.

6. Repeat step 5 with a second D1 square on the remaining end of C to make a C-D1 unit as shown in Diagram 3.

7. Repeat steps 5 and 6 with the remaining C and D1 squares to make a total of 16 C -D1 units. Repeat to make 16 each C-D2 and C-D3 units referring to Diagram 4. Set aside extra pieces for your scrap bag.

8. To complete one blue Star block, select one A-B unit, four E squares and 4 C-D1 units. Referring to Diagram 5, sew a C-D1 unit to opposite sides of the A-B unit to make the center row; press seams toward the A-B unit. Sew an E square to opposite ends of each C-D1 unit to make the top and bottom rows; press seams toward E. Sew these rows to opposite sides of the center row to complete 1 block; press seam toward the center row.

9. Repeat step 8 to complete a total of 4 each blue, pink and purple Star blocks referring to Diagram 6.

Completing the Sashing Blocks:

1. Sew a G1 strip between two F strips to make a blue Sashing block referring to Diagram 7; press seams toward G1. Repeat to make a total of 7 Blue Sashing blocks. Repeat with G2 and F strips and G3 and F strips to make 5 pink and 3 purple Sashing blocks, again referring to Diagram 7.


Quilt Assembly:

1. Arrange and join 2 I rectangles with 2 each H 1 and H 2 rectangles and 4 J strips to make a rectangle row referring to Diagram 8; press seams toward the rectangles. Repeat to make a total of 4 rectangle rows.

2. Arrange and join 4 Star blocks with 5 Sashing blocks to make a star sashing row referring to Diagram 9 for color positioning; press seams toward Sashing blocks. Repeat to make two additional star sashing rows, again referring to the diagram for color positioning.

3. Join the rectangle rows with the star sashing rows referring to the Quilt Diagram to complete the quilt center; press seams toward the rectangle rows.
4. Join the $\mathrm{K} / \mathrm{L}$ strips on the short ends to make a long strip; press. Recut strip into (2) 2" x $771 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ L strips and (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 63^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{K}$ strips. Sew the L strips to opposite long sides and K strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center; press seams toward the strips.
5. Join the $\mathrm{M} / \mathrm{N}$ strips on the short ends to make a long strip; press. Recut strip into (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 80^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{M}$ strips and (2) $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 67^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{N}$ strips. Sew the M strips to opposite long sides and K strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center; press seams toward the M and N strips.
6. Join the $\mathrm{O} / \mathrm{P}$ strips on the short ends to make a long strip; press. Recut strip into (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $84 \frac{1}{2}$ " P strips and (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 69^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ O strips. Sew the O strips to opposite long sides and P strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center; press seams toward the O and P strips.
7. Join the $\mathrm{Q} / \mathrm{R}$ strips on the short ends to make a long strip; press. Recut the strip into (2) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 86^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Q strips and (2) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 78^{1} / 2$ " R strips; press. Sew $Q$ strips to opposite long sides and R strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center to complete the quilt top; press seams toward Q and R strips.
8. Join the $21 / 4$ "-wide purple tonal binding strips with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Trim seams to $1 / 4$ " and press open. Fold the strip with wrong sides together along length and press to make binding.
9. Remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the $86^{\prime \prime}$ edges with a $1 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim edges to make an 86" x 103" backing piece with horizontal seams.
10. Layer, quilt, and bind using your favorite methods and the prepared binding strip to complete the quilt.

## 22973 X: Stripe

- Cut (4) $3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Recut strips into 2 each $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
x $21^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ F strips and (2) $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 271 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ G strips.
- Cut (2) $271 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Recut strips into (2) $271 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ backing squares.


## Completing the Blocks:

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each $B$ square.
2. Referring to Diagram 1, place a B square right sides together with a C1 square and stitch $1 / 4$ " on each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line and press open with seams pressed away from B to complete 2 B-C1 units. Repeat to make a total of 16 B-C1 units.

3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 with $B$ and $C 2$ squares and $B$ and C3 squares to make 8 each B-C2 and B-C3 units referring to Diagram 2.

## Pillow

4. Select 1 each A1 and A2 square and 2 B-C1 units. Join to complete 1 Block A referring to Diagram 3; press seams toward the A1 and A2 squares. Repeat to complete a total of 4 blocks.

5. Repeat step 4 with remaining B-C units and A squares in different combinations to make 4 each Block B, Block B Reversed and Block C, again referring to Diagram 3.

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## Pillow Assembly:

1. Arrange and join the blocks in 2 rows of 4 blocks each referring to Diagram 5; press seams in adjacent rows in opposite directions. Repeat to make a total of 4 rows ( 2 in each combination).

2. Join the rows as stitched to complete the pillow center; press.
3. Sew the D strips to opposite sides and E strips to the top and bottom of the pillow center; press seams toward strips.
4. Sew the F strips to opposite sides and G strips to the top and bottom of the pillow center to complete the pillow top; press seams toward F and G strips.
5. Fold $1 / 4$ " to the wrong side on 1 edge of each $27^{\prime \prime}$ backing square; press. Fold under 4" on the same edge of each square to hem; press, pin and edgestitch to hold in place.
6. Place the pieced pillow top right side up on a flat surface. Place the pillow back pieces right sides together with the pillow top matching raw edges, with hemmed edges overlapping in the center. Stitch all around. Turn right side out through the opening on the back.
7. Insert a 27 " pillow form through the opening to finish.
