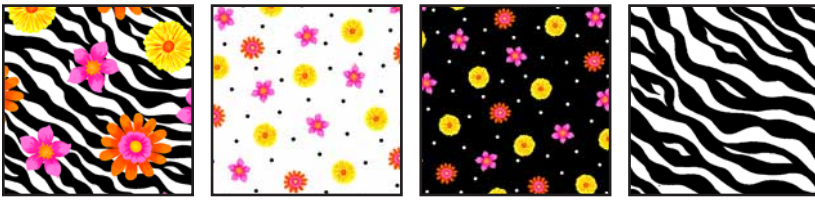

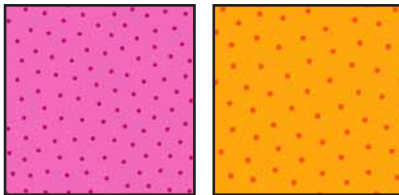

Cutting Directions:

Cutting and piecing may be needed on long strips such as borders.

22959 J:

- Cut 2 pieces 65" x 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " and 2 pieces 71 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ ".
Cut 4 blocks 6 $\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Subcut diagonally for 8 half square triangles (HST's). Use this fabric for backing.

22960 Z:

- Cut 2 blocks 9 $\frac{3}{8}$ " square. Subcut diagonally for 4 HST's.
Cut 4 pieces 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 9 $\frac{3}{8}$ ".

22960 J:

- Cut 10 blocks 6 $\frac{7}{8}$ " square and subcut diagonally for 20 HST's. Cut 4 pieces 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 9 $\frac{3}{8}$ ".

22961 ZJ:

- Cut 2 pieces 57 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " and 2 pieces 62 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ ".

22961 OP:

- Cut 2 blocks 18 $\frac{1}{8}$ " square. Subcut diagonally and subcut diagonally again for 8 large quarter square triangles (QST's). Cut 1 block 13 $\frac{1}{4}$ " square. Subcut diagonally and subcut again diagonally for 4 small QST's. Cut binding strips 2" wide.

22962 S:

- Cut 2 blocks 12 $\frac{7}{8}$ " square and subcut diagonally for 4

HST's. Cut 4 pieces 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

22962 O:

- Cut 2 pieces 62 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " and 2 pieces 2 pieces 65" x 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ ". Cut 2 blocks 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ " square, subcut diagonally and subcut diagonally again for 8 QST's.

22963 P:

- Cut 10 blocks 6 $\frac{7}{8}$ " square and subcut diagonally for 20 HST's.

22963 O:

- Cut 2 strips 2" x 70", 2 strips 2" x 44" (both include a little extra) and 2 strips 16" x 2". Cut 18 strips 2" x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Construction:

Sew with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and fabrics right sides together. Press each seam as you sew, pressing toward the darker fabric.

1. Sew a pink HST to a black floral HST (A below). Sew 20. Sew two HST blocks together (B below). Make 10 units. Sew 2 HST units together to make 5 blocks. See diagram below for the directions for sewing the HST's.



2. Sew a $9\frac{3}{8}$ " white floral piece to a $9\frac{3}{8}$ " black floral piece. Sew an orange QST to each side edge. (See diagram below for placement of pieces). Trim the edges of the $9\frac{3}{8}$ " pieces at a 45 degree angle to a point as indicated by the broken lines. Make 4. Sew a yellow HST to the bottom edge. Make 4 blocks.



3. Sew a black and white zebra floral print HST to each side of the small orange/pink zebra print QST. Make 4. Sew a yellow $12\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to the QST edge to make 4



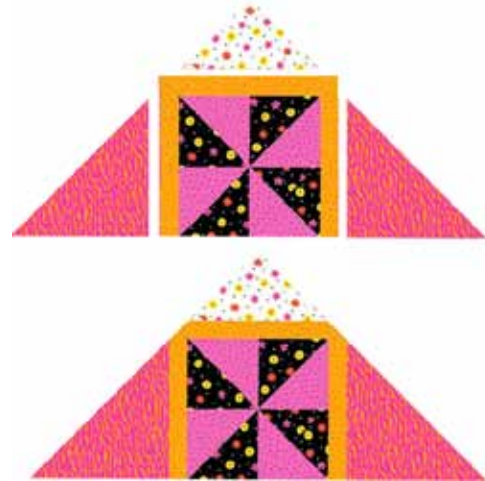
blocks.

4. Sew an orange $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to two side edges of a block completed in no. 1 above. Sew a $16\frac{3}{8}$ " strip to the top



edge. Make 2.

5. Sew a large orange/pink zebra print QST to each side edge of the block. Sew a white floral print HST to the top edge. Trim orange edges even with the diagonal slant of the units. Make 2.



6. Sew a block completed in no. 2 above to each side of 2 blocks sewn in no. 3 above, connecting the blocks with an orange $12\frac{1}{2}$ " piece. Sew an orange piece to each end.



Make 2 rows.

7. Sew an orange/pink zebra print QST to each end. Sew a



44" orange piece to the top edge. Make 2.

8. Sew a block completed in no. 3 above to two opposite sides of a block completed in no. 1 above, joining with a $12\frac{1}{2}$ " orange piece. Sew a block completed in no. 1 above to each end, joining with an orange piece. Sew an orange piece to each end. See the diagram below for arrangement of blocks.

9. Sew a white floral HST to each end. Sew a 70" orange piece to the top and bottom edges. Make 1.



10. Sew the rows together in the order shown below to construct the quilt.



Layer and quilt as desired.

Binding: Sew ends of binding strips together diagonally to form a continuous strip to go all the way around the quilt edge. Sew binding to the front edge of the quilt, right sides together. Miter the corners. Turn the binding to the back and fold a ¼" hem under. Hand stitch the binding to the back.

11. Sew a 57¾" black and white zebra print piece to each side edge. Sew a 62¼" piece to the top and bottom edges.



12. Sew a 62¼" dark orange piece to each side edge and a 65" piece to the top and bottom edges. Sew a 65" piece zebra print with flowers to each side edge and a 71½" piece to the top and bottom edges.

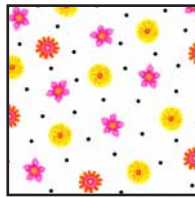

Cutting Directions:

22959 J:

- Cut 4 pieces 18¾" x 3¼", 2 pieces 10" x 3¼" and 2 pieces 10" x 6½".

22960 Z:

- Cut 4 blocks 4⅝" square and subcut diagonally for 8 half square triangles (HST's). Cut 8 pieces 4⅝" x 1¾".

22960 J:

- This will be used for backing.

22961 OP:

- Cut 4 pieces 8" x 1½" and 4 pieces 10" x 1½". Cut 4 blocks 3⅜" square and subcut diagonally for 8 HST's. Cut 4 pieces for pocket using the pattern. Cut 2" wide strips for binding.

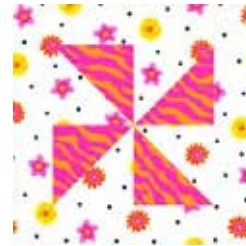
Construction:

Sew with ¼" seam allowance and fabrics right sides together. Press each seam as you sew, pressing toward the darker fabric.

1. Sew a 4⅝" white piece to a straight edge of the orange/pink zebra stripe HST. Let the excess white fabric go to the left edge. Cut excess white fabric edge diagonally as shown in diagram A. Make 8. Sew this unit on the diagonal edge to the white HST. See figure B. Make 8. Sew two HST units together as shown in C. Make 4.



2. Sew 2 HST units (C) together to make a block. Make 2.



3. Sew an 8" orange/pink zebra print piece to two side edges of the block. Sew a 10" piece to the top and bottom edges.



4. Sew the 3¼" wide black/white zebra piece to the left edge of the block and the 6½" wide piece to the right edge. Sew a 18¾" piece to the top and bottom edge. Make 2



Wild Flower Placemats (Makes 2)

5. Sew 2 pocket pieces rights sides together, leaving a 1½" opening on one edge. Turn right side out through the opening and hand stitch the opening closed. Press flat. Make 2. Pin the pockets to the placemat as shown below and sew ¼" from edge, leaving the top edge open.



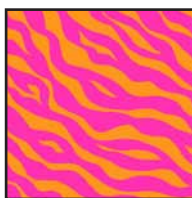
Layer and quilt as desired.

Binding: See instructions above for the Wallflower Quilt for binding.

Cutting Directions:

22959 J:

- Cut 2 pieces 15" H x 18½" W. Cut 2 pieces 15" x 6"

22961 OP:

- Cut 1 piece 23½" x 6". Cut 2 pieces 3" x 18½". Cut 2 pieces 3" x 28" for straps.

22962 O:

- Cut 2 pieces 17¾" H x 18½" W and 1 piece 51¾" x 6" for the lining. Cut 2 pocket pieces 8½" x 4½".

Cotton low loft batting:

- Cut 2 pieces 17½" H x 18½" W and 1 piece 52" x 6".
- Cut 2 pieces 1" x 28".

Construction:

Sew with ¼" seam allowance except where indicated otherwise. Sew fabrics right sides together. Press each seam as you sew.

1. Sew 2 orange pocket pieces rights sides together, leaving a 1½" opening on one edge. Turn right side out through the opening and hand stitch the opening closed. Press flat.
2. Sew a 18½" orange/pink zebra piece to one edge of a black/white/floral zebra piece. Make 2.



3. Make a gusset - sew a 6" wide black/white/floral zebra print piece to one end of the 6" wide orange/pink zebra piece. Sew a black/white/floral zebra piece to the other end of the orange/pink zebra piece.



4. Lay the 2 front and back pieces and the gusset piece above on top of the corresponding pieces of batting, right side up. Pin together and quilt as desired.
5. Pin the pocket on one piece for the front and sew ⅛" from edge, leaving the top edge of the pocket open.



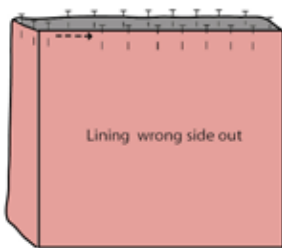
6. Pin the gusset strip to the side and bottom edges of the front piece with the pocket, RST and matching seams. At the bottom corners, clip in the seam area of the side panel for ease in turning. Sew together. Repeat to sew the back side piece to the other long edge of the gusset.
7. Repeat no. 6 above to sew the orange lining front and back pieces to the lining gusset.

8. Lay a 1" wide batting strip centered on the wrong side of one of the orange/pink zebra print 3" wide strap pieces. Wrap the side edges of the fabric over the batting and fold back a hem back on the edge of the top piece. You may have to adjust the fabric so that the folded hem is next to a side edge. Pin and sew around the strap $\frac{1}{8}$ " from the side edges. Repeat to make 2 straps.
9. Lay the zebra stripe bag unit flat, right side out. Align the ends of one strap to the top edge about 9" apart and pin. Repeat with the other strap, pinning to the other side piece.



10. With the orange lining turned wrong side out and the bag turned right side out, place the bag inside the lining. Align top edges and pin, making sure the straps are tucked down between the bag and lining. **Sew top edges with a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance, leaving a 4" opening.** Turn right side out and press seam flat. Hand stitch the opening closed. Pull straps up out of the way and top stitch around the top edge of the bag $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge, going through all layers.

Placemat Pocket
Cut 2 for each placemat
