## 23494 B: Fabric C (blue squiggles print)

## Block A

- Cut (2) 16 " x WOF strips. Subcut (24) 2" x 16" rectangles then subcut (4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
- Cut (1) 14" x WOF strip. Subcut (20) 2" x 14" rectangles.


## Pillow Front

- Cut (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Subcut (1) $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangle.


## 23495 B: Fabric D (blue stripe)

## Block B

- Cut (6) $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Subcut (12) $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{1} / 2$ " rectangles.


## Pillow Front

- Cut (1) $10^{1 / 2 "}$ x WOF strip. Subcut (1) $10^{1 / 2 "}$ x $20^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.


## 23496 B: Fabric E (blue circles print)

## Block B

- Cut (4) $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Subcut (24) $61 / 2$ " x $14^{1} / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.

Quilt Instructions

## Block A

1. Referring to Diagram 1, sew one 2" x 14 " Fabric C rectangle to opposite sides of $12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square, allowing ends of Fabric C rectangles to extend beyond Fabric A square. Trim Fabric C ends even with Fabric A square. Press seams away from block center. Make 12 Unit A. Diagram 1

2. Referring to Diagram 2, sew one 2" x 16" Fabric C rectangle to top and bottom of each Unit A. Trim Fabric C ends even with block. Press seams away from block center.

3. Trim all 12 blocks to $14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$, making sure side frames are the same width and top/bottom frames are the same width.

## Block B

4. Referring to Diagram 3, sew one $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangle between two $6^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E rectangles. Press seams towards the center of the block. Block B should measure $14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make a total of 12 Block B.

## Quilt Center Assembly

1. Quilt Row Unit 1: Referring to Diagram 4 and noting orientation of the blocks, sew blocks together in the following order: Block A, B, A, B. Make a total of three Row Unit 1.

2. Quilt Row Unit 2: Referring to Diagram 5 and noting orientation of the blocks, sew blocks together in the following order: Block B, A, B, A. Make a total of three Row Unit 2.

3. Referring to the Quilt Layout Diagram, sew rows together in the following order: Row Unit 1, 2, 1, 2, 1, 2. Quilt Center should measure $561 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 841 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

4. Outer Border: Sew one $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 84^{1} / 2$ " Fabric B rectangle to each long side of the Quilt Center. Sew one $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ x $641 / 2$ " Fabric B border to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Quilt Top should measure $641 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 841 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Quilt Finishing

1. Prepare backing to measure $72^{\prime \prime} \times 99$ ". Press seams open.
2. Layer the Quilt Top right side up on top of the batting and wrong side of the backing fabric.
3. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired.
4. Sew the nine $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strips together (end to end) using $45^{\circ}$ seams to make a continuous strip. Fold strip in half lengthwise (with wrong sides together) and press. Bind as desired.

## Pillowcase Instructions

## Pillowcase Front

1. Referring to Diagram 1, noting orientation of the pieces, sew the $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 20^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle between the $24^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B rectangle and $10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ 20 $1 / 2$ " Fabric D rectangle.

2. At the raw edge of the Fabric D rectangle and with wrong sides together, turn under a $1 / 4$ " seam and press. Measuring from the fold line and with wrong sides together, turn under $5^{\prime \prime}$ and press. The folded edge of the Fabric D rectangle should align with the wrong side seam between the Fabric C and Fabric B rectangles. The Front should measures $30^{1} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Sew the flap in place using an edge stitch (and edge-stitch sewing machine foot).

## Pillowcase Back

3. At the raw short edge of the $351 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangle and with wrong sides together, turn under a $1 / 4$ " seam and press. Measuring from the fold line and with wrong sides together, turn under $5^{\prime \prime}$ and press. The Back should measures $30^{1} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$. Sew the flap in place using an edge stitch (and edge-stitch sewing machine foot).

## Join Front to Back

4. With right sides together and matching the flap seams, join front to back with $1 / 4$ " seam along each long side and the short side of the Fabric B rectangles.
5. Finish all raw seams with a zigzag stitch.

## Pillowcase Finishing

1. Turn the pillowcase right side out.
2. Press all seams.
