## **Cutting Directions**

*Note:* A widthwise cut (WOF) is from selvage to selvage.

# 23484 A: Fabric A (dk brown dish print) Block A

• Cut (4) 1½" x **WOF** strips. Subcut (6) 1½" x 2½" rectangles; (6) 1½" x 4½" rectangles; (6) 1½" x 6½" rectangles and (6) 1½" x 8½" rectangles.

# 23484 E: Fabric B (tan dish print) Block B

• Cut (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x **WOF** strip. Subcut (4)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

# 23484 E: Fabric C (It green toss print) Outer Border

• Cut (4) 3½" x **WOF** strips. Subcut (2) 3½" x 30½" and (2) 3½" x 36" rectangles.

# 22542 AE: Fabric D (toffee tonal) Block B

• Cut (3) 1½" x *WOF* strips. Subcut (4) 1½" x 2½" rectangles; (4) 1½" x 4½" rectangles; (4) 1½" x 6½" rectangles and (4) 1½" x 8½" rectangles.

#### Block C-1 and C-2

• Cut (2) 1½" x **WOF** strips. Subcut (4) 1½" x 7½" rectangles and (4) 1½" x 8½" rectangles.

### 22542 T: Fabric E (terracotta tonal)

#### Inner Border #2

• Cut (4) 3/4" x **WOF** strips. Subcut (2) 3/4" x 30" rectangles and (2) 3/4" x 301/2" rectangles.

#### Binding

• Cut (5) 2½" x **WOF** strips.

### 23078 EA: Fabric F (beige texture)

## Block A and B

- Cut (1) 2½" x **WOF** strip. Subcut (5) 2½" squares.
- Cut (3) 1½" x **WOF** strips. Subcut (10) 1½" x 4½" rectangles. Subcut (10) 1½" x 6½" rectangles.

#### Block C-1 and C-2

• Cut (2) 1½" x **WOF** strips. Subcut (4) 1½" x 6½" rectangles. Subcut (4) 1½" x 7½" rectangles.

### Sashing Rectangles

• Cut (2) 1½" x **WOF** strips. Subcut (6) 1½" x 8½" rectangles.

#### Sashing Rows

• Cut (2) 1½" x **WOF** strips. Subcut (2) 1½" x 26½" rectangles.

#### Inner Border #1

• Cut (4) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x **WOF** strips. Subcut (2) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 26<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles. Subcut (2) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 30" rectangles.





## **Quilt Instructions**

#### Block A

1. Referring to Diagram 1, sew one 2½" Fabric F square between two 1½" x 2½" Fabric A rectangles for Unit A. Sew one 1½" x 4½" Fabric A rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit A. Unit A should measure 4½" square. Diagram 1









2. Referring to Diagram 2, sew Unit A between two 1½" x 4½" Fabric F rectangles for Unit B. Sew one 1½" x 6½" Fabric F rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit B. Unit B should measure 6½" square.

3. Referring to Diagram 3, sew Unit B between two 1½" x 6½" Fabric A rectangles for Unit C. Sew one 1½" x 8½" Fabric A rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit C. Block A should measure 8½" square. Make a total of 3 Block A.

#### Block B

- 4. Referring to Diagram 1, sew one 2½" Fabric F square between two 1½" x 2½" Fabric D rectangles for Unit A. Sew one 1½" x 4½" Fabric D rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit A. Unit A should measure 4½" square.
- 5. Referring to Diagram 2, sew Unit A between two 1½" x 4½" Fabric F rectangles for Unit B. Sew one 1½" x 6½" Fabric F rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit B. Unit B should measure 6½" square.

6. Referring to Diagram 3, sew Unit B between two 1½" x 6½" Fabric D rectangles for Unit C. Sew one 1½" x 8½" Fabric D rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit C. Block B should measure 8½" square. Make a total of 2 Block B.

#### Block C-1


7. Referring to Diagram 4 and noting orientation of the pieces, sew one 1½" x 6½" Fabric F rectangle to the right side of one 6½" Fabric B square for Unit D. Sew one 1½" x 7½" Fabric F rectangle to the top of Unit D. Sew one 1½" x 7½" Fabric D rectangle to the right side of Unit D. Sew one 1½" x 8½" Fabric D rectangle to the top of Unit D. Block C-1 should measure 8½" square.



#### Block C-2

8. Referring to Diagram 5 and noting orientation of the pieces, sew one 1½" x 6½" Fabric F rectangle to the left side of one 6½" Fabric B square for Unit E. Sew one 1½" x 7½" Fabric F rectangle to the bottom of Unit E. Sew one 1½" x 7½" Fabric D rectangle to the left side of Unit E. Sew one 1½" x 8½" Fabric D rectangle to the bottom of Unit E. Block C-2 should measure 8½" square.

#### Quilt Row Assembly

1. Block Row 1: Referring to Diagram 6, noting orientation of the blocks, sew blocks and sashing together in the following order: Block A, one 1½" x 8½" Fabric F rectangle, Block C-1, one 1½" x 8½" Fabric F rectangle, Block B.

2. Block Row 2: Referring to Diagram 7, noting orientation of the blocks, sew blocks and sashing together in the following order: Block C-2, one 1½" x 8½" Fabric F rectangle, Block A, one 1½" x 8½" Fabric F rectangle, Block C-2.

3. Block Row 3: Referring to Diagram 8, noting orientation of the blocks, sew blocks and sashing together in the following order: Block B, one 1½" x 8½" Fabric F rectangle, Block C-1, one 1½" x 8½" Fabric F rectangle, Block A. Diagram 8



## Quilt Center Assembly

**Note:** For the following steps, refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram.

4. Sew Quilt Center Rows and Sashing Rows together in the following order: Block Row 1, one 1½" x 26½" Fabric F rectangle, Block Row 2, one 1½" x 26½" Fabric F rectangle, Block Row 3.

- 5. Inner Border #1: Sew one 2½" x 26½" Fabric F rectangle to each opposite side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 2¼" x 30" Fabric F rectangle to top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure 30" square.
- 6. Inner Border #2: Sew one ¾" x 30" Fabric E rectangle to each opposite side of the Quilt Center. Sew one ¾" x 30½" Fabric E rectangle to top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure 30½" square.
- 7. Outer Border: Sew one 3½" x 30½" Fabric C rectangle to each opposite side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 3½" x 36" Fabric E rectangle to top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Quilt Top should measure 36" square.

### **Finishing**

- 1. Layer the Quilt Top right side up on top of the batting and wrong side of the backing fabric.
- 2. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired.
- 3. Sew the five 2½" x **WOF** Fabric E strips together (end to end) using 45° seams to make a continuous strip. Fold strip in half lengthwise (with wrong sides together) and press. Bind as desired.
