## Cutting Directions

Note: A widthwise cut (WOF) is from selvage to selvage.

## 23484 A: Fabric A (dk brown dish print)

Block A

- Cut (4) $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Subcut (6) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $2^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles; (6) $1^{11 / 2 " ~ x ~} 4^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles; (6) $1^{11 / 2 " ~ x ~} 6^{1 / 2 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (6) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2 "$ rectangles.


## 23484 E: Fabric B (tan dish print)

Block B

- Cut (1) $6^{1 / 2}$ x $x$ WOF strip. Subcut (4) $6^{1 / 2}$ " squares.


## 23484 E: Fabric C (lt green toss print)

## Outer Border

- Cut (4) $31 / 4$ x WOF strips. Subcut (2) $3^{1 / 1 / 4}$ " x $301 / 2$ " and (2) $3^{11 / 4 "} \times 36$ " rectangles.


## 22542 AE: Fabric D (toffee tonal)

## Block B

- Cut (3) $11 / 2$ x x WOF strips. Subcut (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $2^{1} / 2$ " rectangles; (4) $1^{11 / 2 "} \times 4^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles; (4) $1^{11 / 2 " ~ x ~} 6^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles and (4) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2 "$ rectangles.


## Block C-1 and C-2

- Cut (2) $11 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Subcut (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $71 / 2$ " rectangles and (4) $11 / 2$ " $\times 81 / 2$ " rectangles.


## 22542 T: Fabric E (terracotta tonal)

Inner Border \#2

- Cut (4) $3 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Subcut (2) $3 / 4$ " x 30 " rectangles and (2) $3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 30^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
Binding
- Cut (5) $2^{1 ⁄ 21} 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips.

23078 EA: Fabric F (beige texture)
Block A and B

- Cut (1) $2^{1} / 22^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Subcut (5) $2^{1} / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
 rectangles. Subcut (10) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2 "$ rectangles.
Block C-1 and C-2
- Cut (2) $11 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Subcut (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $61 / 2 "$ rectangles. Subcut (4) $1^{11 / 2}$ " $\times 7^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.


## Sashing Rectangles

- Cut (2) $11 / 2$ x X WOF strips. Subcut (6) $1^{1 ⁄ 2}$ " x 8½" rectangles.


## Sashing Rows

- Cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Subcut (2) $1^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles.
Inner Border \#1
- Cut (4) $21 / 4 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. Subcut (2) $21 / 4 " \mathrm{x} 261 / 2 "$ rectangles. Subcut (2) $2^{1 / 1 / 4} \times 30^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.


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## Quilt Instructions

## Block A

1. Referring to Diagram 1, sew one $2^{1} / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F square between two $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles for Unit A. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit A. Unit A should measure $41 / 2$ " square. Diagram 1

2. Referring to Diagram 2, sew Unit A between two $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $41 / 2$ " Fabric F rectangles for Unit B. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit B. Unit $B$ should measure $6^{1 / 2}$ square.

3. Referring to Diagram 3, sew Unit B between two $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles for Unit C. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $8^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit C. Block A should measure $81 / 2$ " square. Make a total of 3 Block A.

## Block B

4. Referring to Diagram 1, sew one $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F square between two $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangles for Unit A. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit A. Unit A should measure $41 / 2$ " square.
5. Referring to Diagram 2, sew Unit A between two $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangles for Unit B. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit B. Unit $B$ should measure $61 / 2 "$ square.
6. Referring to Diagram 3, sew Unit B between two $11 / 2$ " x $61 / 2$ " Fabric D rectangles for Unit C. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $8^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit C. Block B should measure $81 / 2$ " square. Make a total of 2 Block B.

## Block C-1

7. Referring to Diagram 4 and noting orientation of the pieces, sew one $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangle to the right side of one $6^{1} / 2$ Fabric B square for Unit D. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F rectangle to the top of Unit D. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangle to the right side of Unit D. Sew one $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8{ }^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangle to the top of Unit D. Block C-1 should measure $8^{1 / 2 "}$ square. Diagram 4


## Block C-2

8. Referring to Diagram 5 and noting orientation of the pieces, sew one $11 / 2$ " x $6^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric F rectangle to the left side of one $6^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B square for Unit E. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F rectangle to the bottom of Unit E. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D rectangle to the left side of Unit E. Sew one $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D rectangle to the bottom of Unit E. Block C-2 should measure $81 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square.

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## Quilt Row Assembly

1. Block Row 1: Referring to Diagram 6, noting orientation of the blocks, sew blocks and sashing together in the following order: Block A, one $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangle, Block C-1, one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangle, Block B.

2. Block Row 2: Referring to Diagram 7, noting orientation of the blocks, sew blocks and sashing together in the following order: Block C-2, one $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $81 / 2$ " Fabric F rectangle, Block A, one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangle, Block C-2.

3. Block Row 3: Referring to Diagram 8, noting orientation of the blocks, sew blocks and sashing together in the following order: Block B, one $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $8^{1 / 2}$ " Fabric F rectangle, Block C-1, one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangle, Block A.

## Quilt Center Assembly

Note: For the following steps, refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram.
4. Sew Quilt Center Rows and Sashing Rows together in the following order: Block Row 1 , one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 26^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangle, Block Row 2, one $1 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangle, Block Row 3.
5. Inner Border \#1: Sew one $21 / 4$ " x $26^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric F rectangle to each opposite side of the Quilt Center. Sew one $21 / 4 " \times 30$ " Fabric F rectangle to top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure 30" square.
6. Inner Border \#2: Sew one $3 / 4$ " x 30" Fabric E rectangle to each opposite side of the Quilt Center. Sew one $3 / 4 \mathrm{x}$ x $301 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E rectangle to top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure $30^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
7. Outer Border: Sew one $3^{11 / 4 " ~ x ~} 30^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle to each opposite side of the Quilt Center. Sew one $3^{11 / 4 "}$ x 36 " Fabric E rectangle to top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Quilt Top should measure 36" square.

## Finishing

1. Layer the Quilt Top right side up on top of the batting and wrong side of the backing fabric.
2. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired.
3. Sew the five $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric E strips together (end to end) using $45^{\circ}$ seams to make a continuous strip. Fold strip in half lengthwise (with wrong sides together) and press. Bind as desired.
