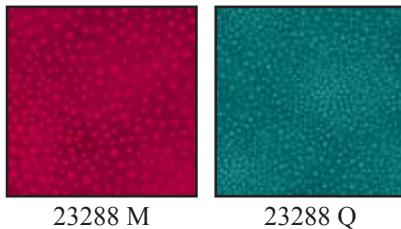
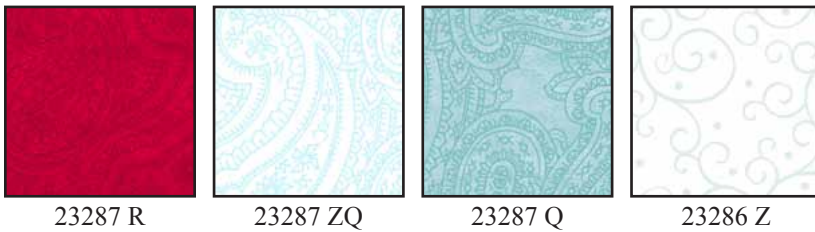
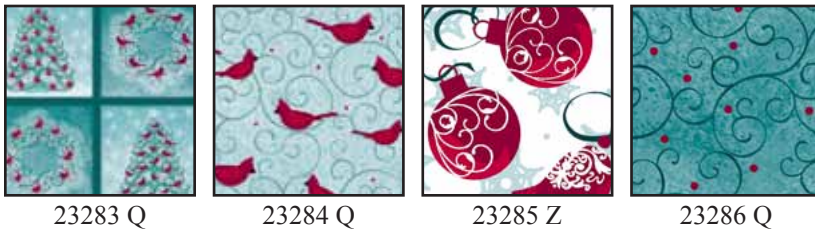


Winter Enchantment Quilt

Cutting Directions:

Note: A widthwise cut (WOF) is from selvage to selvage.

A. 23283 Q: Panel

- Fussy cut six 11½" squares.

B. 23284 Q: Birds

- Cut one 5" x 72½" strips from the length of fabric (LOF).

From remaining fabric

- Cut four 5" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two 5" x 54½" strips.
- Cut one 3½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3½" squares.

C. 23285 Z: Ornaments

- Cut two 12½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into six 12½" squares.

D. 23286 Q: Teal Swirls

- Cut four 6½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 6½" squares.

E. 23287 R: Red Paisley

- Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two 2" x 72½" strips.
- Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two 2" x 54½" strips.

- Cut eight 2½" x WOF strips for the binding.

F. 23287 ZQ: White Paisley

- Cut four 1½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 1½" x 11½" strips.
- Cut four 1½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 1½" x 13½" strips.

G. 23287 Q: Blue Paisley

- Cut nine 3½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into ninety-six 3½" squares.

H. 23286 Z: White Swirls

- Cut nine 6½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into ninety-six 3½" x 6½" strips.

I. 23288 M: Red Dots

- Cut nine 3½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into ninety-six 3½" squares.
- Cut six 2" x WOF strips.

J. 23288 Q: Teal Dots

- Cut six 2" x WOF strips.

23285 Z: Ornaments

- Cut two 92" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 74" x 92" for the backing.

Block One:

1. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of one $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat with the remaining Fabric F strips and Fabric A squares to make six Block One centers total.

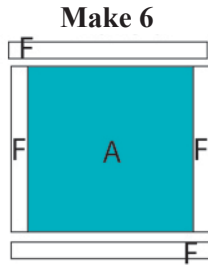

2. Place one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square on the left side of one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

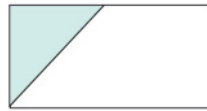

3. Place $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I square on the right side of the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 5). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make one G/H/I unit.

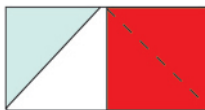

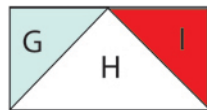

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make forty-eight G/H/I units total.

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and follow Figure 6 to make forty-eight I/H/G units using forty-eight $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strips, forty-eight $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I squares and forty-eight $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G squares.

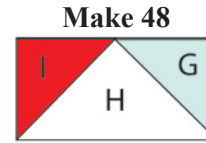

6. Sew one 2" x WOF Fabric I strip and one 2" x WOF Fabric J strip together, lengthwise, to make one I/J strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make six I/J strips total. Sub-cut the strips into (112) 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " I/J units (Fig. 8)

7. Sew two I/J units together to make one four-patch block (Fig. 9). Repeat to make fifty-six four-patch blocks total.

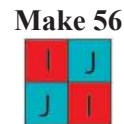

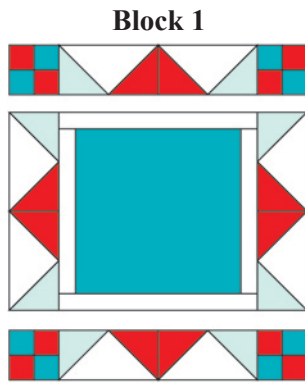


Figure 10 **Make 6**

8. Sew one G/H/I unit and one I/H/G unit together to make one side strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew one strip to each side of the Block One center to make the middle row. (Fig. 10)
9. Sew two four-patch blocks, one G/H/I unit and one I/H/G unit together to make top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew the three rows together to complete one Block One square (Fig. 10).

10. Repeat Steps 8-9 to make six Block One squares total.

Block Two:

11. Place one 6½" Fabric D square on the top left corner of one 12½" Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 11). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 12). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam.

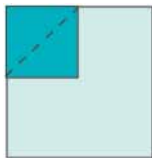

12. Follow Figure 13 for the seam direction to add a 6½" Fabric D square to each of the remaining corners of the 12½" Fabric C square to make one Block Two center. (Fig. 14)

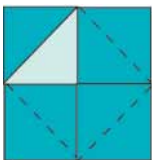

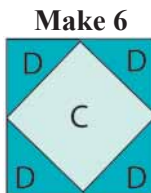

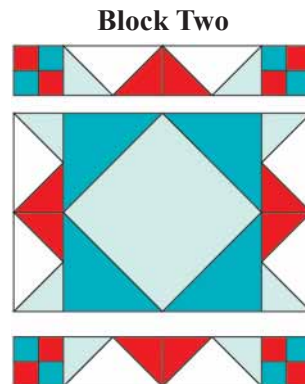


Figure 15 **Make 6**

13. Sew one G/H/I unit and one I/H/G unit together to make one side strip. Repeat to make a second side strip. Sew one strip to each side of the Block Two center to make the middle row (Fig. 15).

14. Sew two four-patch blocks, one G/H/I unit and one I/H/G unit together to make the top border. Repeat to make the bottom border. Sew the three rows together to complete one Block Two square (Fig. 15).

15. Repeat Steps 11-14 to make six Block Two squares total.

Corner Block:

16. Sew two four-patch blocks and two 3½" Fabric B squares together to make one Corner Block (Fig. 16). Repeat to make four Corner Blocks total.

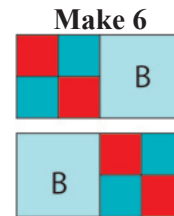

Assembling the Quilt Top:

Refer to quilt layout while assembling.

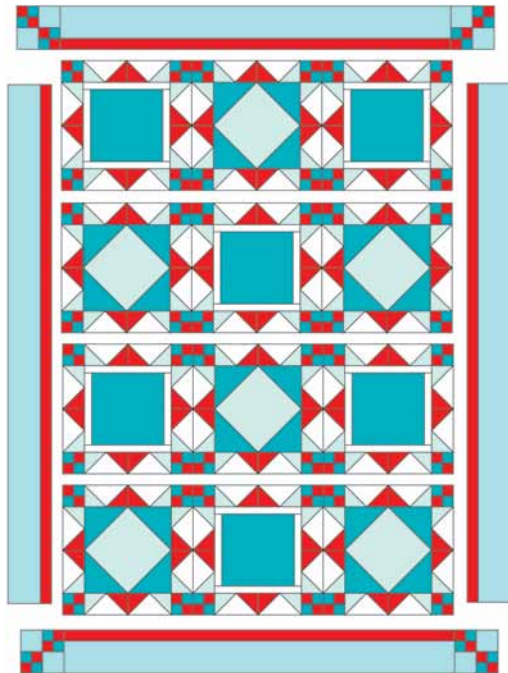
17. Sew two Block Ones and one Block Two together to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

18. Sew two Block Twos and one Block One together to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.

19. Sew the four rows together in numerical order to complete the quilt top.

Winter Enchantment Quilt

20. Sew one 5" x 72½" Fabric B strip and one 2" x 72½" Fabric E strip together, lengthwise, to make one side border strip. Repeat to make a second side border strip. Sew one side border strip to each side of the quilt top.
21. Sew one 5" x 54½" Fabric B strip and one 2" x 54½" Fabric E strip together, lengthwise, to make one top/bottom border strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew one Corner Block to each end of both strips. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.



Quilt Layout

Finishing:

22. Layer and quilt as desired.
23. Sew the eight 2½" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
24. Bind as desired.
