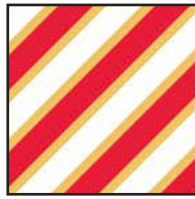

Design:	Yards
23250 RZ	1 PANEL
23253 ZR	2/3
23253 ZS	7/8
23254 R	1/4
23254 S	1/4
23255 ZR	2/3
Thin Cotton Batting	1

Cutting Directions:

A. 23250 RZ: Panel

- Cut panel blocks apart directly on the edges of each block and cutting through the red/white corner designs. Blocks should measure 10" x 11 1/4". Trim 1/8" from both sides of each block so that blocks measure 10" x 11".

B. 23253 ZR: Red/White Snowflake

- Cut (8) 2 1/2" strips for strip sets.

C. 23253-ZS: Gold/White Snowflake

- Cut (2) 2" strips for strip sets.
- Cut (6) 2 1/2" strips for strip sets.
- Cut (1) 3" strip for strip sets.

D. 23254 R: Red Text Print

- Cut (3) 1 1/2" strips; subcut (8) 1 1/2" x 11" and (4) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- Cut (1) 1 1/2" strip for strip set.

E. 23254 S: Gold Text

- Cut (3) 1 1/2" strips; subcut (8) 1 1/2" x 11" and (4) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- Cut (1) 1 1/2" strip for strip set.

F. 23255 ZR: Diagonal Stripe

- Cut (8) 2 1/2" strips for binding.

Cotton Batting

- Cut (4) 13 1/2" x 18 1/2" rectangles.

Construction:

Strip Set 1:

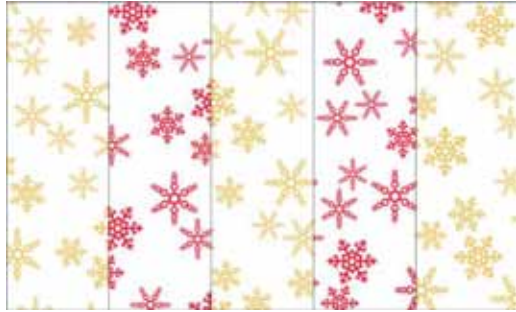
1. Sew strips together in the following order. Make 1.
 - (C) 2 1/2" gold snowflake; (B) 2 1/2" red snowflake; (C) 3" gold snowflake; (B) 2 1/2" red snowflake; (C) 2 1/2" gold snowflake
2. Press seams toward the (B) red snowflake strips. Press both back and front to ensure that there are no pleats along the seams.
3. Subcut strip set into (8) 2 1/2" segments.

Strip Set 2:

1. Sew strips together in the following order. Make 2.
 - (C) 2 1/2" gold snowflake; (B) 2 1/2" red snowflake; (C) 2" gold snowflake; (B) 2 1/2" red snowflake; (C) 2 1/2" gold snowflake.
2. Press seams toward the (B) red snowflake strips. Press both back and front to ensure that there are no pleats along the seams.
3. Subcut strip sets into (8) 6 1/2" segments.

Strip Set 3:

1. Sew one (D) 1½" red text strip to one (B) 2½" red snowflake strip. Press toward the (D) strip. Make 1.
2. Subcut strip set into (4) 6½" segments.

Strip Set 4:

1. Sew one (E) 1½" gold text strip to one (B) red snowflake strip. Press toward the (E) strip. Make 1.
2. Subcut strip set into (4) 6½" segments.

Panel Blocks:

1. Sew one (D) 1½" x 11" red strip to the bottom of a panel block. Press toward the strip. Sew one (D) 1½" x 11" red strip to the right side of the panel block. Press toward the strip. Make 4.
2. Repeat Panel Block step 1 using (E) 1½" x 11" gold strips. Make 4.

Assembly:

1. Sew a (D) 1½" x 2½" red rectangle to the end of one Strip Set 1 segment. Press toward the strip set segment. Make 4.

2. Repeat Assembly step 1 using (E) 1½" x 2½" gold rectangles.



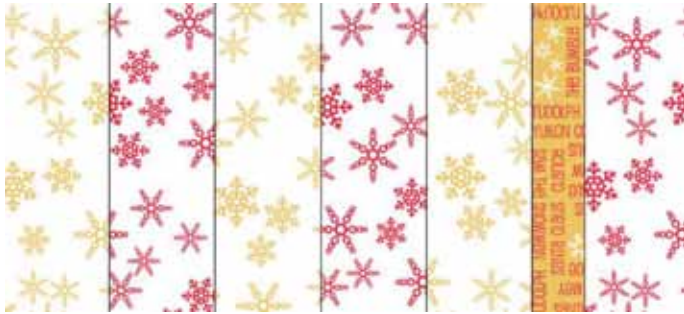

3. Sew a segment from Strip Set 3 to one end of a Strip Set 2 segment placing the red text strip next to the SS2 segment. Make 4.

4. Repeat Assembly step 3 using Strip Set 2 and Strip Set 4 segments. Place gold text strip next to the SS2 segment. Make 4.

7. Sew a unit from Assembly step 3 to a block from Assembly step 5. Press toward the block. Make 4.

5. Sew a unit from Assembly step 1 to the bottom of a red framed panel block. Press toward the panel block. Make 4.

8. Sew a unit from Assembly step 4 to a block from Assembly step 6. Press toward the block. Make 4.

6. Sew a unit from Assembly step 2 to the bottom of a gold framed panel block. Make 4.

Finishing:

1. With wrong sides together, place a red placemat with a gold placemat placing one piece of batting between layers. Pin to hold layers together.
2. Machine quilt along seams.
3. Trim if necessary so that layers are even.
4. Prepare binding using (F) 2½" strips. Sew to placemats using your preferred method.
