## General Information:

- All seams are sewn with a $1 / 44^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance.
$-\mathbf{W O F}=$ Width of Fabric is from Selvage to Selvage.
- Label all pieces when cut for less confusion.
- This quilt is sewn together in COLUMNS.


## Special Notions:

Rotary Cutter, Mat, Rulers, Straight Pins, Sewing machine, thread to sew your seams, and Sulky ${ }^{\circledR}$ Poly Deco ${ }^{\text {TM }} 40$ wt. Thread \#962-1193 for quilting.

Step 1: Cutting the Fabric:

1. Fabric A: $\mathbf{2 3 2 1 2} \mathbf{L}$

- Cut (2) strips at $22 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times \mathbf{W O F}$ - Sub-cut into (5) $22 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 81⁄2" rectangles
From the balance of the fabric:
- Cut (2) $161 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
- Cut (8) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2$ " rectangles

2. Fabric B: 23213 L/23213 J

- Cut (1) strip at $181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF - Sub-cut into (2) $181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and (2) $16^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
- Cut (1) strip at $12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF - Sub-cut into (2) $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and (2) $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
- Cut (1) strip at $6^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF and use the balance of the fabric from above to cut (10) $61 / 2 " \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

3. Fabric C: $\mathbf{2 3 2 1 5}$ XL / 23215 J

- Cut (2) strips at $10^{1 / 2}$ " x WOF - Sub-cut into (2) $10^{1 / 2 / 2} \mathrm{x}$ $24^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (2) $8^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2}$ " rectangles.
- Cut (1) strip at $181 / 2$ " x WOF - Sub-cut into (2) $181 / 2$ " x $10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (6) $6^{1} / 2$ " $\times 4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.

4. Fabric D: $\mathbf{2 3 2 1 7}$ Z / 23217 J

- Cut (5) strips at 4" x WOF (Outer Border - SIDES)
- Cut (5) strips at 51/4" x WOF (Outer Border - TOP/ BOTTOM)
- Cut (2) strips at $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF - Sub-cut into (2) $41 / 2$ " x $18 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, (2) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, and (2) $4^{1} / 2$ " x $61 / 2$ " rectangles.

5. Fabric E: $\mathbf{2 3 2 1 6}$ L / 23216 V

- Cut (1) strip at $61 / 2$ x $x$ WOF - Sub-cut into (8) $61 / 2$ " x $41 / 2$ " rectangles
- Cut (17) strips at 2" x WOF (Border 1 and 3)
- Cut (9) strips at $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF (Binding)

6. Fabric F: $\mathbf{2 3 2 1 4}$ Z / 23214 J

- Cut (4) strips at $2^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF (Border 2 - SIDES)
- Cut (4) strips at $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF (Border 2 - TOP/ BOTTOM)

7. Fabric G: 21521 Z / 21521 J

- Cut (1) strip at $10^{1 / 2}$ x W OF - Sub-cut into (22) $10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $11 / 2$ rectangles
- Cut (1) strip at $22^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF - Sub-cut as follows:
- Cut (10) $22^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
- Cut (8) $16 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles


## Step 2 - Block A and B:

8. Sew (1) Fabric G $22^{1} 1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " to each side of (1) Fabric A $22^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8{ }^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.
9. Sew (1) Fabric G $10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{1 / 2}$ " to the top and bottom to finish BLOCK A at $24^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ - Make (5).
10. Sew (1) Fabric G $16^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " to each side of (1)

Fabric A $16^{1 / 2 "}$ x $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
11. Sew (1) Fabric G $10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 / 1^{\prime \prime}$ to the top and bottom to finish BLOCK B at $18^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ - Make (2).

## Step 3 - Block C:

12. Sew (1) Fabric G $16^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " to each side of (1) Fabric B $16^{1 / 2 "}$ x $81 / 2^{\prime 2}$.
13. Sew (1) Fabric G $10^{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x} 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " to the top and bottom to finish BLOCK C at $18^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2}$ " - Make (2).


Step 4 - Block D:
14. Sew (1) Fabric G $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " to each side of (1) Fabric C $10^{1 / 2 " ~ x ~} 8^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.
15. Sew (1) Fabric G $10^{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x} 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " to the top and bottom to finish BLOCK D at $12^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ - Make (2).

## Step 5 - Sewing the Quilt Center:

- This quilt is sewn together in COLUMNS.
- The ODD numbered columns are sewn together at the $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ edge.
- The EVEN numbered columns are sewn together at the 4½" edge.
- The FABRIC is listed from TOP to BOTTOM and are sewn from LEFT to RIGHT.
- Each column will be $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $72 \frac{1}{2}$ " OR $41 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 721 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
- Refer to the "CENTER LAYOUT" for a guide.

16. Column 1 and 9 - Block A, Fabric C $24122^{\prime \prime}$, Block A - Make (2).
17. Column 2 and 8 - Fabric A $6^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$, Fabric B $12^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$, Fabric D 6½", Fabric E 6-1/2", Fabric A 612", Fabric B 6½", Fabric C 6½", Fabric E $6122^{\prime \prime}$, Fabric D $12 ½$ ", Fabric B 6½" - Make (2).
18. Column 3 and 7 - Block B, Fabric B 18½", Fabric C 18½", Block C - Make (2).
19. Column 4 and 6 - Fabric C $6 ½$ ", Fabric A $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, Fabric E $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, Fabric B $6^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$, Fabric D $181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, Fabric B $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, Fabric A $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, Fabric C 6½", Fabric B 6½", Fabric E 6½" - Make (2).
20. Column 5 (CENTER) - Block D, Fabric B $12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$, Block A, Fabric B 12½", Block D.
21. Sew the columns together to finish the quilt center at $661 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (NOTE: Column 6, 7, 8, and 9 will flip).


While all possible care has been taken to ensure the accuracy of this pattern, we are not responsible for printing errors or the way in which individual work varies.

## Step 6 - Adding the Borders:

22. Sew the $2^{\prime \prime}$ strips of Fabric E together at the $2^{\prime \prime}$ edge then sub-cut into the following:
a. (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles - Border 1 Sides
b. (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 69^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles - Border 1 Top/Bottom
c. (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 79^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles - Border 3 Sides
d. (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x} 77$ " rectangles - Border 3 Top/Bottom
23. Border 2 - SIDES - Sew Fabric F $2^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips together at the $23 / 4$ " edge then sub-cut into (2) $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 75^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
24. Border 2 - TOP/BOTTOM - Sew Fabric F $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips together at the $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ edge then sub-cut into (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 74 ".
25. Outer Border - SIDES - Sew Fabric D 4" strips together at the $4^{\prime \prime}$ edge then sub-cut into (2) $4^{\prime \prime} \times 821 / 2 "$.
26. Outer Border - TOP/BOTTOM - Sew Fabric D 5¼" strips together at the $51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ edge then sub-cut into (2) 5¼" x 84".
27. Sew on one border at a time always sewing the SIDES first then the TOP/BOTTOM beginning with Border 1 to finish the quilt top at $84^{\prime \prime} \times 92^{\prime \prime}$.

## Step 8 - Finishing the Quilt:

28. Layer the backing, batting, and quilt top and quilt as desired.
29. Using the Fabric E $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips sew on the binding to finish the quilt.
