


Beginner Quilting Skills Quilt Designed by Vicki Niro

CUTTING: Label pieces

20571-T (panel print): Fussy Cut (6) dog faces 61/2" x 61/2" Fussy Cut center image 23%" x 27"

20574-G (green foliage): Following the Selvage

Cut (3) 71/4" strips. Sew short ends.

Subcut (1) 71/4" x 333/4" and (1) 71/4" x 401/2"

Following Width of Fabric. Cut (3) 71/4" xWOF(approx.20") Sew short ends.

Subcut (1) 71/4" x 301/8", (1) 71/4" x 23%"

20579-F (green wave, dark): Cut (5) 11/2" x WOF

Subcut (8) 1½" x 8½", (8) 1½" x 6½", (4) 1½" x 7½" Cut (7) 21/2" x WOF (binding)

20575-G (green cattail, medium): Cut (2) 11/2" x WOF

Subcut (4) 11/2" x 61/2", (4) 11/2" x 41/2" 20576-G (green fish, light): Cut (1) 11/2" x WOF

Subcut (4) 11/2" x 21/2", (4) 11/2" x 41/2"

20575-T (orange cattail, dark): Cut (3) 11/2" x WOF

Subcut (12) 1½" x 7½", (2) 1½" x 6½", (2) 1½" x 8½"

Cut (8) 21/2" x WOF. Subcut (2) 21/2" x 401/2"

Sew short ends of (6) strips. Subcut (2) 21/2" x 561/8" and (2) 21/2" x 441/2"

20575-S (yellow cattail, medium): Cut (2) 11/2" x WOF Subcut (8) 11/2" x 51/2"

20576-S (yellow fish, light): Cut (1) 11/2" x WOF

Subcut (8) 11/2" x 31/2"

20579-B (blue wave): Cut (1) 21/2" x WOF

Subcut (4) 21/2" x 21/2"

20573-B (water scene): Following the Selvage

Cut (3) 61/2" strips. Sew short ends. Subcut (2)

61/2" x 601/8"

Following Width of Fabric. Cut (6) 61/2" xWOF(approx. 22")

Sew short ends. Subcut (2) 61/2" x 561/2"

20574-S (orange foliage): Cut (2) pieces 21/4 yards, backing. This is directional fabric. Sew one long edge, press open.





IMAGE 2 = Make 4



SEWING:

Make 4 Log Cabin Blocks **IMAGE 3**

Start at the center with Blue Wave 21/2" x 21/2" Working light to dark with your fabrics as you go around the square.




Sew remaining blocks per IMAGE 1 and IMAGE 2.

Sew blocks into 2 rows; follow image below.

Create the Center Block by sewing the Green Foliage pieces to each side, using the log cabin sewing method; see image below.



Assemble the quilt rows; see above image.

Add left and right side inner borders and then the top and bottom inner borders. Repeat with the outside borders.

Layer and machine quilt as desired. This is a great quilt for stitch in the ditch. Don't forget to use your walking foot/dual feed foot.
