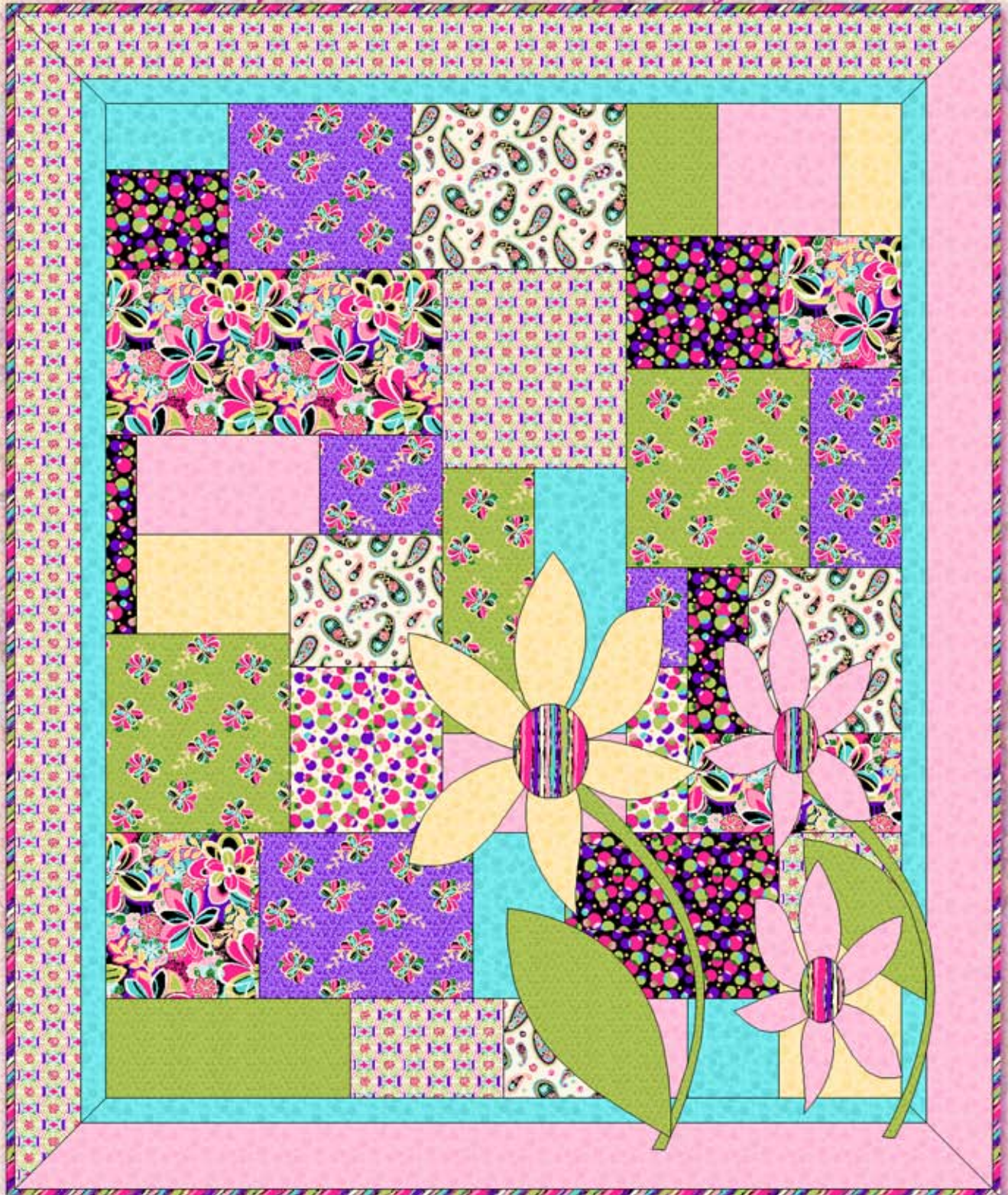

NOTE - Label each piece with the number in the () dimensions are listed length X width

Additional Materials: Fusible Webbing – 1½ yard

21274V – Multi Color

Cut 1 strip, 11 ½" x Width of Fabric (WOF), Sub cut 12 ½" x 11 ½" (16), 6½" x 9 7/8" (35), 6½" x 7 ¾" (39)

Cut 4 strips, 4½" x WOF, diagonally join short ends together, trim and press seam open.

Sub cut 1 strip, 4½" x 61" and 1 strip, 4½" x 73" **OUTER BORDER**

21275E – Paisley

Cut 1 strip, 13 1/8" x WOF, Sub cut 10 ½" x 13 1/8" (4), 6 ½" x 9 ¾" (9), 2 ½" x 9 ¾" (11), 10 ½" x 9 5/8" (26), 6½" x 8" (36)

21277H – Green

Cut 1 strip, 15" x WOF, Sub cut 6½" x 15" (34) 8½" x 6 1/8" (18), use remainder for stem and leaf appliques.

21279V – Purple Flower

Cut 1 strip, 13 3/8" x WOF, Sub cut 10 ½" x 13 3/8" (31), 10 ½" x 11¾" (3), 12 ½" x 6" (24), 6" x 7½" (7), 6 ½" x 4 ¼" (28),

21279H – Green Flower

Cut 1 strip, 16 ½" x WOF, Sub cut 16 ½" x 6" (14), 12 ½" x 11¾" (23), 12 ½" x 11 5/8" (13)

21278J – Black Dots

Cut 1 strip, 13 3/8" x WOF, Sub cut 10 ½" x 13 3/8" (33), 12" x 2 3/8" (10), 8 ½" x 10" (21), 10 ½" x 4 ¼" (25), 6 ½" x 8" (2)

21278E – White Dots

Cut 1 strip, 10 ½" x WOF, Sub cut 10 ½" x 4 ¼" (29), 10 ½" x 9 ¾" (12)

21264S – Yellow

Cut 1 strip, 10 ½" x WOF, Sub cut 10 ½" x 7 ¾" (40) 6 ½" x 9 ¾" (8), 8 ½" x 4 ¼" (20) and 24"x 22" for the large flower appliqué.

21264Q – Teal

Cut 1 strip, 16½" x WOF, Sub cut 16½" x 6" (15), 10 ½" x 6 1/8" (32), 6½" x 6" (38) 4 ½" x 8" (1)

Cut 7 strips, 2" x WOF, diagonally join short ends together, trim and press seam open. Sub cut (2) strips, 2" x 61" and (2) 2" x 73" **INNER BORDER**

21264P – Pink

Cut 1 strip, 11 ½" x WOF, Sub cut 6 ½" x 11 ½" (6), 6" x 11 ½" (17), 8 ½" x 7 ¾" (19), 6 ½" x 4 3/8" (37) and 2 rectangles, 16" x 12" each for the small pink flower appliques.

Cut 4 strips, 4½" x WOF, diagonally join short ends together, trim and press seam open.

Sub cut 1 strip, 4½" x 61" and 1 strip 4½" x 73" **OUTER BORDER**

21273V – Black Flower

Cut 1 strip, 20 7/8" x WOF, Sub cut 10 ½" x 20 7/8" (5), 8 ½" x 7 ¾" (22), 6½" x 13 3/8" (27), 10½" x 9 7/8" (30)

21276V – Stripe BINDING

Cut 7 strips, 2½" x WOF, diagonally join short ends together, trim and press seam open. Fold in half lengthwise wrong side's together, finger press. Cut a piece of fabric 12" x 12" for the Flower centers.

21280Q – Wording BACKING

Cut 2- 2¼ yards, Sew along the selvage using a 1" seam allowance. Trim seam to ½" and press open.

Refer to Quilt Top Assembly Diagram

Block Assembly- All seams are sewn with a ¼" seam allowance. Press all seams to the dark fabric.

Block Units are created by sewing cut pieces together, following numerical order as followed below.

Sew blocks 1, 2, 3, & 4 together to form unit A. Block 5 will form unit B.

Sew blocks 6, 7, 8, 9, & 10 together to form unit C. Sew blocks 11, 12 & 13 together to form unit D

Sew blocks 14, 15, 16, & 17 together to form unit E.

Sew blocks 18, 19, & 20 together to form unit F

Sew blocks 21 & 22 together to form unit G. Sew blocks 23 & 24 together to form unit H

Sew blocks 25, 26, 27, 28 & 29 together to form unit I.

Sew blocks 30, 31, 32 & 33 together to form unit J

Sew blocks 34, 35, 36, 37 & 38 together to form unit K.

Sew blocks 39 & 40 together to form unit L

Assemble units referring to Quilt Top Assembly Diagram

1. Join the long bottom side of unit B to the top of unit C; now join Unit D to the bottom of unit B/C. Now join Unit E to the right side of unit B/C/D. Set this aside, this will be unit B/C/D/E.
2. Join the long bottom side of unit F to the top of unit G. Join the long top side of unit H to the bottom of unit F/G. Join the long top side of unit I to the bottom of unit F/G/H. Set this aside, this will be unit F/G/H/I.
3. Join the long bottom side of unit J to the top of unit K. Set this aside, this will be unit J/K.
4. Join unit L to the short right side of unit J/K. Set this aside this will now be assembly 2.
5. Join unit B/C/D/E to the long bottom side of unit A. Now join this to the long left side of unit F/G/H/I. This will now be assembly 1.
6. Join assembly 1 to the top of assembly 2.

Borders: Sew the Teal strips 1 - 2" x 61" and 1 - 2" x 73" to the Pink 2" x 61" and 2" x 73", match the sizes together. Repeat with the remaining Teal 2" x 61" and 2" x 73" and the Multicolor strips 2" x 61" and 2" x 73" = Border Strip Set (BSS). Make 2 in each color way.

1. On the wrong side of the Quilt top, place a 1/4" mark in each corner.
2. Find the center of the 4 BSS, mark with a pin on the Inner Border Fabric.
3. Measure the Quilt Center's length (side borders) and width (top/bottom borders) through the center of the quilt top. Divide each measurement half. Using this measurement place a mark , 1/4" in from the raw edge, on either side the center pin of the top/bottom BSS or the side BSS.
4. Find the center of all four sides of the Quilt Center, mark with a pin. Attach the BSS to the sides and the top/bottom of the Quilt Center, matching the center pins. Watch color placement, look a Quilt Image. The marks made on both sides of the 2 BSS should match the marks made on the corners of the Quilt Center.
5. Sew the BSS starting at 1/4" corner mark and ending at the 1/4" corner mark. Leave long thread tails, do not knot or use reverse sewing. DO NOT trim the extra BSS fabric. Repeat this on all 4 sides. Press seam towards the BSS.

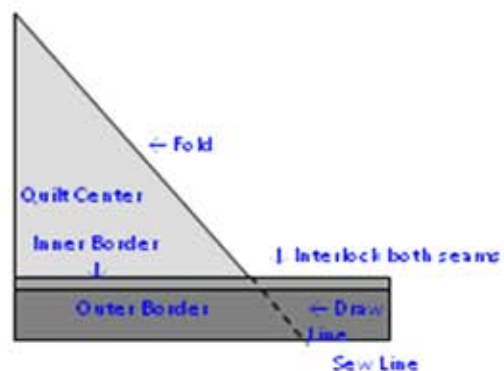
6. Fold the quilt in half diagonally, right sides together as shown in Diagram 2. Your extra BSS fabric should extend to the right. Line up the bottom BSS fabric edges and interlock the BSS seams, pin in place. Draw a line extending the diagonal fold through the BSS. The drawn line will be your sew line. Sew on drawn line, leaving long thread tails, open quilt to make sure that the intersection lays flat. Tie off thread tails. Cut away excess fabric, press seam open. Repeat this on remaining 3 corners.

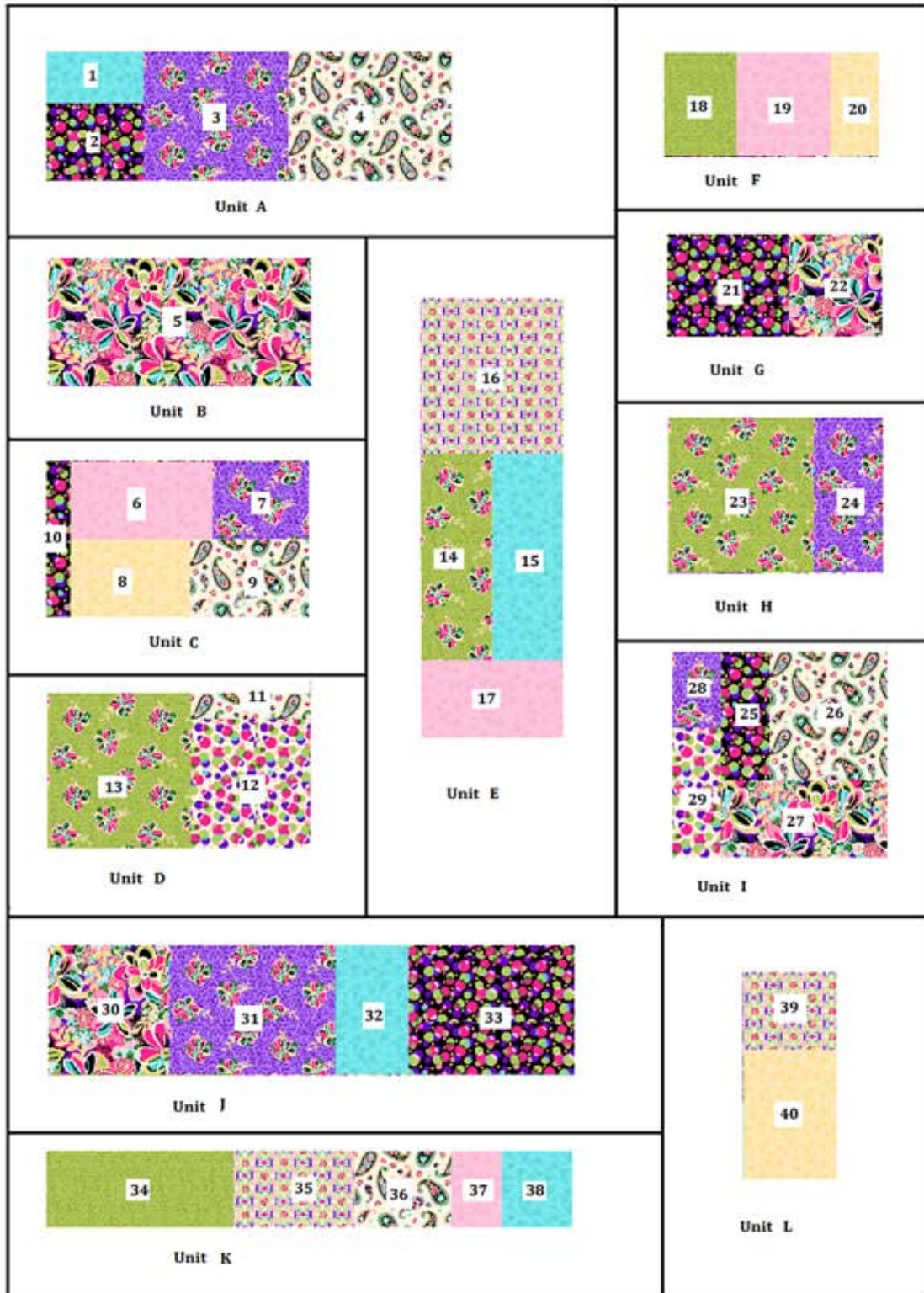
Fusible Appliqué – Enlarge the appliqué pattern to the size of your choice (we recommend 400%) Trace each shape onto the fusible webbing. Using the manufacturer's method, fuse each shape to the wrong side of your fabric choice. Fuse pieces to the quilt top. Top stitch appliqué in place using your favorite machine stitch. Stabilize the underside of the quilt, beneath the appliqué motifs, before stitching them in place.

Place mark 1/4" down and 1/4" in from the side. Repeat all 4 corners
