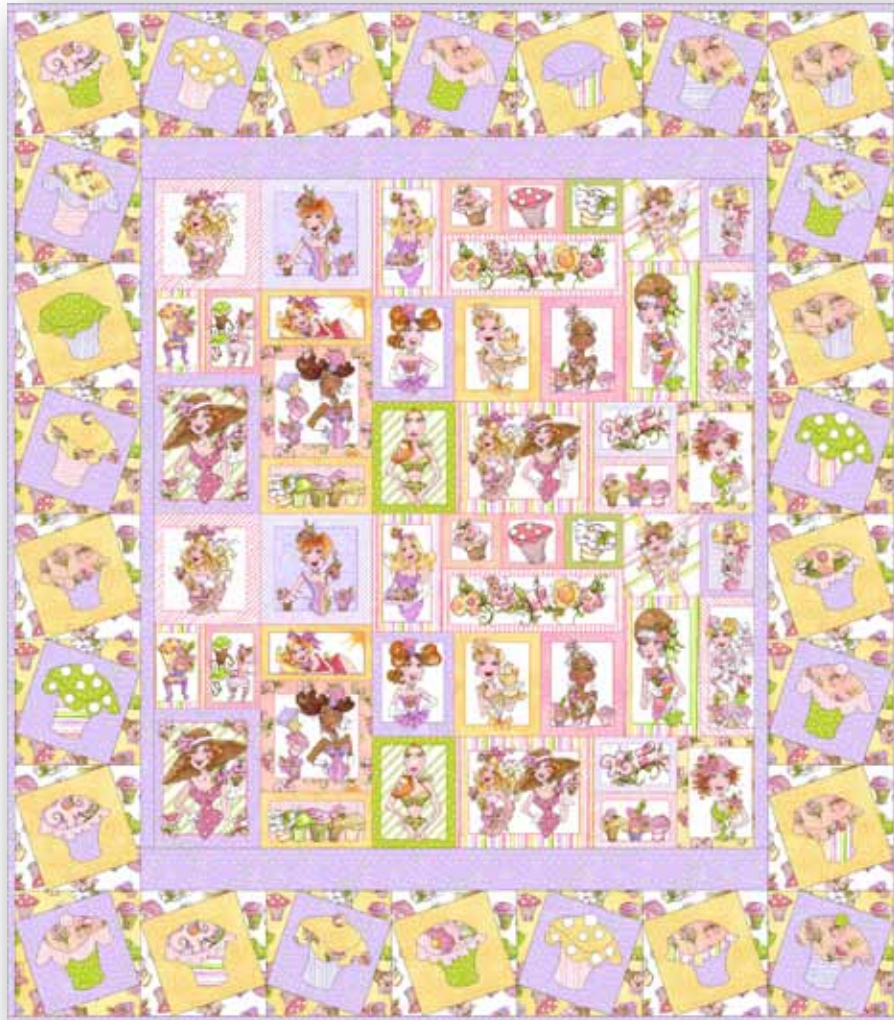

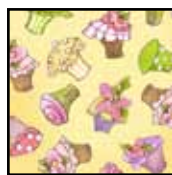

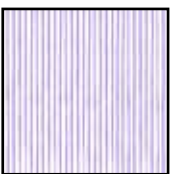

Skill level – Intermediate

CUTTING WOF = width of fabric

Hey Cupcake Panel 21967 PL

- Cut two panels to size, approx. 23 ¼" h x 43" w
- Be sure to leave a ¼" seam allowance at the top and bottom of the panels and trim off the selvage from both sides.

Lilac Dots 21974 L

- Cut 10 strips @ 2½" WOF (borders & binding)
- Cut 3 strips 5 ½" x WOF (borders)
- Cut 3 strips @ 7⅝" x WOF, sub cut 13 squares @ 7⅝" x 7⅝, Use remaining fabric for cupcake appliques.

Yellow Dot 21974 S

- Cut 3 strips @ 7⅝" x WOF, sub cut 13 squares @ 7⅝" x 7⅝, Use remaining fabric for cupcake appliques.

White Cupcake Toss 21969 Z

- Cut 7 strips @ 2⅞" x WOF; sub cut 26 rectangles 2⅞" x 8 ⅝".
- With the printed side up, cut the rectangles on the diagonal as shown.
- Use pieces of remaining white background for dots on cupcake appliques.



Yellow Cupcake Toss 21969 S

- Cut 7 strips @ 2⅞" x WOF; sub cut 26 rectangles 2⅞" x 8 ⅝".
- With the printed side up, cut the rectangles on the diagonal as shown.



Green Dots 21974 H

- Use for cupcake appliques.

Pink Small Flower Toss 21971 P

- Use for cupcake appliques.

Yellow Small Flower Toss 21971 S

- Use for cupcake appliques.

Pink Multi Stripe 21972 P

- Use for cupcake appliques.

Pink Simple Stripe 21973 P

- Use for cupcake appliques.

Lilac Simple Stripe 21973 L

- Use for cupcake appliques.

Pink Jumbo Flower Toss 21968 P

- Use ¼ yard for cupcake appliques.
- Piece remaining 4 yards into quilt back.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew with ¼" seam allowance and all fabrics right sides together. Press each seam toward the darker fabric as you sew.

1. Carefully matching bottom of one panel with top of the other, sew the two panels together to form the quilt center.
2. **Note:** Extra width has been provided in the Lilac Dots strips. Sew 3 Lilac Dots 2½" wide strips together with diagonal seams, sub cut 2 strips @ 47" long. Sew the strips to sides of quilt center. Trim the strips even with the raw edge of the quilt center. Sew the Lilac Dots 5 ½" wide strips together with diagonal seams, sub cut 2 strips @ 47" long. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Trim borders so that the quilt center measures 45½" w x 54½" h, keeping the panel evenly centered within the borders.

2. Sew long side of White Cupcake Toss triangles to all four sides of the Yellow Dots squares. See the image below. Each completed block should measure 9½” x 9½”, including seam allowances.



3. Sew long side of Yellow Cupcake Toss triangles to all four sides of the Lilac Dots squares. See the image below. Each completed block should measure 9½” x 9½”, including seam allowances.

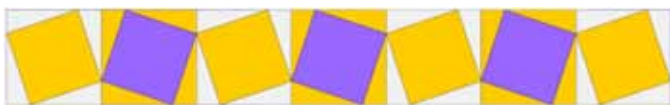


4. Using your favorite applique technique and referring to diagrams for layouts, applique cupcakes to each of the assembled blocks, varying fabric placement for interest.

5. See the image below for block placement, sew six applique blocks together to form a border for each side. Sew borders to sides of quilt.



6. See the image below for block placement, sew seven applique blocks together to form a border for the top border. Sew border to top of quilt.



7. See the image below for block placement, sew seven applique blocks together to form a border for the bottom border. Sew border to bottom of quilt.



Layer and quilt as desired.

Binding:

Sew ends of the 7 remaining Lilac Dots 2½” x WOF strips together with diagonal seams. Fold assembled strip in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to right side of quilt, mitering corners. Turn binding to back of quilt and slipstitch in place.

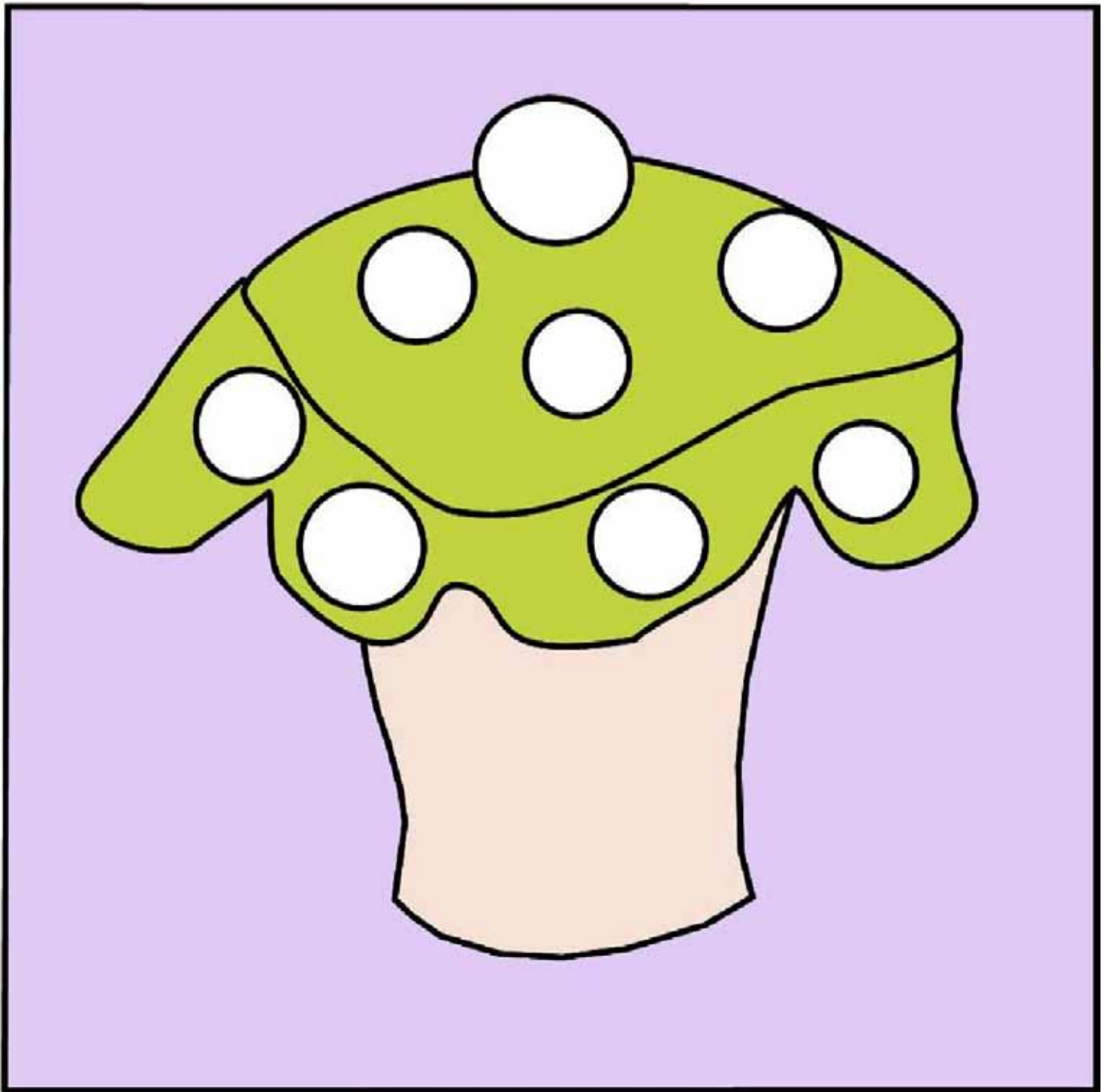
