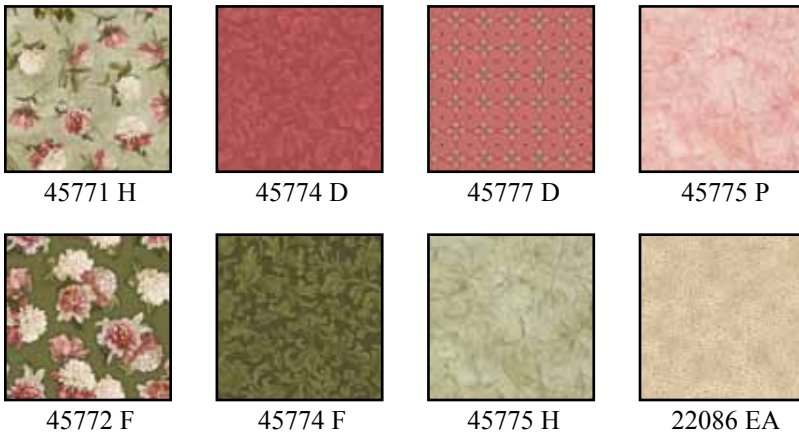


Peony Blush Quilt

Cutting:

WOF = Width Of Fabric

Fabric A 45771H Light green large floral

- (3) strips 2 1/2" x WOF. Border 2.
- (4) strips 4 1/2" x WOF. Border 4 sides.
- (4) strips 6 1/2" x WOF. Border 4 top and bottom.
- (9) strips 3 1/2" x WOF. Outside borders.
- (1) 24 1/2" x 32 1/2" rectangle. Center Block.

Fabric B 45774D Dark Pink tonal

- (14) strips 2 1/2" x WOF. Keyboard blocks.

Fabric C 45777D Med Pink print

- (5) strips 2 1/2" x WOF. Border 1.
- (10) strips 2 1/2" x WOF for binding.

Fabric D 45774F Dark Green

- (6) strips 3 3/8" x WOF. Sub cut (62) 3 3/8" squares. Square in Square block.

Fabric E 45775P Pink

- (7) strips 2 1/2" x WOF. Keyboard Blocks
- (7) strips 4 1/2" x WOF. Sub cut (100) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. Keyboard blocks.
- (1) strip 2 7/8" x WOF. Sub cut (8) 2 7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal. Square in Square block.

Fabric F 45772F Dark Green large floral

- (7) strips 2 1/2" x WOF. Keyboard blocks
- (7) strips 4 1/2" x WOF. Sub cut (112) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. Keyboard blocks.
- (4) 4 1/2" squares. Inner Keyboard block corner squares.

Fabric G 45775H Light green tonal

- (9) strips 2 7/8" x WOF. Sub cut (116) 2 7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal. Square in Square block.

Backing Options:

45774F Dark Green Above

or

22086EA - 3 Yards

- 108" width backing from Back to Basics II

Block Assembly:

Keyboard Block: 8 1/2" unfinished.

Sew together lengthwise, a Fabric B and E 2 1/2" strip to make strip set as shown in Diagram 1. Repeat to make 7 strip sets and set aside all but one for now. Press to dark. Cross cut (2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" units a.



Diagram 1

Sew a Fabric E 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle to the right side of each unit a as shown, to complete unit b.



Make 2

Sew two units b together side by side for the pink half of the block as shown



Repeat this process, sewing a Fabric B to the bottom of an F 2 1/2" strip to make strip set shown in diagram 2. Make 7 strip sets, and set all but one aside. Cross cut (2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" units c, and sew a Fabric F 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle to the left side of unit c, making unit d. Sew two units d together to make the green half of the block.

Cut off (2) 2 1/2" units c →

Units d.

Sew the green half to the top of the pink half to complete the block. Repeat this process using the remaining strip sets to make 48 blocks.



Inside Corner Block: 8 1/2" unfinished

Using remaining strip sets and directions for the Keyboard block, make (2) units d, and (1) unit a. Sew a Fabric E 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle to the left side of a unit a to make unit e.



Unit e.

Sew a Fabric F 4 1/2" square to the left side of a unit d. This is the top half of the block. Now sew a rotated unit d to the left side of a rotated unit e as shown for the bottom half. Sew the top half to the bottom half to complete the block. Make 4.

Square in a Square Block: 4 1/2" unfinished

Sew a Fabric G 2 7/8" triangle, long sides to all four sides of a Fabric D 3 3/8" square.



Make 58

Sew a Fabric E 2 7/8" triangle, long sides to all four sides of a Fabric D 3 3/8" square.



Make 4

Outside Corner Block: 8 1/2" unfinished

Using remaining strip sets and directions for the Keyboard block, make (2) units d. Sew a unit d to the right side of a Fabric G/D Square in a Square Triangle to complete top half of the block. Sew a rotated unit d to the left side of a Fabric E/D Square in a Square block for the bottom half of the block. Sew the top half to the bottom half to complete block. Make 4.

Quilt Assembly:

Sew (4) Keyboard Blocks together side by side. Make 2 sets, and sew to the long sides of the Fabric A 24 ½" x 32 ½" rectangle, pink side to center. Sew (3) Keyboard Blocks together in a row. Sew an Inner Corner Block to each end, rotating to match pink sides as shown. Make 2. Sew to the top, rotate and sew to bottom of the quilt center.

Border 1 :

Sew Fabric C 2 ½" strips together end to end. Sub cut (2) 2 ½" x 48 ½" strips and sew to sides of quilt center. Sub cut (2) 2 ½" x 44 ½" strips and sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border 2:

Sew Fabric A 2 ½" strips together end to end. Sub cut (2) 2 ½" x 52 ½" strips and sew to sides of quilt. There are no top and bottom borders.

Border 3:

Sew (13) Fabric D/G Square in a Square blocks together into a row. Make 2. Sew to sides of quilt. Sew (14) Fabric D/G Square in a Square blocks together into a row. Make 2. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border 4:

Sew Fabric A 4 ½" strips together end to end. Sub cut (2) 4 ½" x 60 ½" strips and sew to sides of quilt center. Sew Fabric A 6 ½" strips together end to end. Sub cut (2) 6 ½" x 64 ½" strips and sew to top and bottom of quilt.



Outer Keyboard Border:

Sew (9) Keyboard Blocks together side by side. Make 2 sets, and sew to the sides of the quilt center, pink side to center. Sew (8) Keyboard Blocks together in a row. Sew an Outer Corner Block to each end, rotating to match pink sides as shown in photo. Make 2. Sew to the top, rotate and sew second one to bottom of the quilt center.

Border 5:

Sew Fabric A 3 ½" strips together end to end. Sub cut (2) 3 ½" x 88 ½" strips and sew to sides of quilt center. Sub cut (2) 3 ½" x 86 ½" strips and sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Layer quilt, quilt as desired and bind using the Fabric C 2 ½" strips.
