3. 23031E:

• Cut (4) 5" x 9" rectangles (Block A).

4. 23032A – Cut as follows:

- Cut (2) strips at 1" x **WOF** Sub-cut into (4) 1" x 19" rectangles (Block A).
- Cut (1) strip at 1" x **WOF** Sub-cut into (4) 1" x 9" rectangles (Block A).
- Cut (1) strip 1" x **WOF** Sub-cut into (2) 1" x 13" rectangles (Block A).
- Cut (1) strip at 4½" x **WOF** Sub-cut into (36) 1" x 4½" rectangles – Label A (Outer Border).

5. 23032H:

• Cut (2) 2½" x 13" rectangle.

6. 23032T:

• Cut (2) 2½" x 13" rectangle.

7. 23032S:

• Cut (2) strips at 2" x **WOF** – Sub-cut into (2) 2" x 19" rectangles and (1) 2" x 31" rectangle (Sashing), Cut (4) strips at 1¹/₄" x **WOF** – Sub-cut into (2) 1¹/₄" x 31" (Sides) and (2) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " for the Inner Border.

8. 23029H:

• Cut (6) 4½" squares - Label C (Outer Border)

General Information:

- All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam allowance.
- Pre-wash and press with spray starch.
- **WOF** = *Width of Fabric from selvage to selvage.*
- Press all seams open as will decrease bulk.
- Center Blocks are 181/2" x 141/2" finished.
- Outer Border Blocks are 4" square finished.
- After the pieces are cut for the Outer Border label as directed for less confusion.

Special Notions:

Rotary Cutter, Mat, Rulers, Straight Pins, Sewing Machine, and threads to match your fabrics

Cutting Directions:

1. 23026 A – Fussy Cut as follows:

- Jars -(2) 9" squares.
- Tins (2) 19" x 15" rectangles.

2. 23030 ES:

• Cut (1) strip at 9" x **WOF** – Sub-cut into (4) 9" x 3" rectangles (Block A), Cut (5) strips at 2½" x WOF (Binding), from the balance of the fabric cut (18) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3½" rectangles – Label B (Outer Border).



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9. 23028X:

• Cut (8) 4½" squares – Label E (Outer Border).

10. 23027S:

• Cut (8) 4½" squares - Label D (Outer Border).

Sewing Block A:

- 11. Sew the following together from left to right at the 9" edge to make the center at 19" x 9" ---- (1) 23031E 5" x 9" rectangle, (1) 23032A 1" x 9" rectangle, Jars 9" square, (1) 23032A 1" x 9" rectangle, (1) 23031E 5" x 9" rectangle Make (2) as shown in Example A.
- **12.** Sew (1) 23032A 1" x 19" rectangle to the top and bottom to measure 19" x 10" Make (2).
- **13.** Sew the following together from left to right to make a new strip at 5½" x 13" ----- (1) 23032H 2½", (1) 23032A 1", (1) 23032T 2½", (1) 23032A 1" Make (2) Sub-cut into (8) 5½" x 3" rectangles.
- 14. Sew (1) of the rectangles just completed to each 3" edge of (1) 23030ES 9" x 3" rectangle to make a new rectangle at 19" x 3" Make (4) as shown in Example B.
- **15.** Sew (1) of the rectangles just completed to the top and bottom of the rectangle sewn in Instruction No. 12 to finish Block A at 19" x 15" Make (2).

Example A



Sewing the Center of the Wallhanging and Inner Border:

- **16.** Sew (1) 23032S 2" x 19" rectangle (Sashing) between (1) Block A and (1) Panel 19" x 15" rectangle with Block A on the bottom (left side).
- 17. Sew (1) 23032S 2" x 19" rectangle (Sashing) between (1) Panel 19" x 15" rectangle and (1) Block A with Block A at the top (right side).
- **18.** Sew (1) 23032S 2" x 31" rectangle between the two sections to finish the quilt center at 39" x 31".

19. Sew (1) 23032S $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 31" rectangle to each side then sew (1) 23032S $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top and bottom for the Inner Border at $40\frac{1}{2}$ " x $32\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Outer Border:

Note: When sewing the borders keep in mind the direction of the fabric.

- **20.** Top Border Sew together as follows from left to right at the 4½" edge to measure 4½" x 40½": A, B, A, C, A, B, A, D, A, B, A, C, A, B, A, E, A, B, A, D --- Sew to the TOP of the CENTER.
- 21. Bottom Border Sew together as follows from left to right at the 4½" edge to measure 4½" x 40½": D, A, B, A, E, A, B, A, C, A, B, A, D, A, B, A, C, A, B, A --- Sew to the BOTTOM of the CENTER.
- **22.** Left Side Border Sew together as follows from left to right at the 4½" edge to measure 4½" x 40½": E, E, A, B, A, C, A, B, A, D, A, B, A, E, A, B, A, E --- Sew to the LEFT SIDE of the CENTER.
- 23. Right Side Border Sew together as follows from left to right at the 4½" edge to measure 4½" x 40½": E, A, B, A, E, A, B, A, D, A, B, A, C, A, B, A, E, E --- Sew to the RIGHT SIDE of the CENTER to finish the quilt top at 48½" x 40½".

Finishing the Placemats:

- **24.** Layer the 23031T backing, batting and quilt top and quilt as desired.
- **25.** Using the 23030ES $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips sew on the binding to finish the placemats.

General Information:

- All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam allowance.
- Pre-wash and press with spray starch.
- **WOF** = *Width of Fabric from selvage to selvage.*
- Press all seams open as will decrease bulk.
- Finished Block is 14" square.

Special Notions:

Rotary Cutter, Mat, Rulers, Straight Pins, Sewing Machine, and threads to match your fabrics

Cutting Directions:

1. 23027 S:

• Cut (4) 8" x 4" rectangles.

2. 23027 T:

• Cut (4) 8" squares.

3. 23028 X:

• Cut (4) 4" squares.

4. 23029 S:

• Cut (2) 2½" x 12½" rectangles and (2) 2½" x 12" rectangles.

5. 23030 A:

• Cut (5) strips at $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x **WOF** (Binding).

6. 23031 E:

• Cut (1) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21" rectangle – sub-cut into (2) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, (2) 12" x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, and with the balance of the fabric cut (4) 8" x 4" rectangle and (4) 31/4" squares.

7. 23031 T:

• Cut (4) strips at 3¹/₄" x **WOF** (Border).

8. 23032 T:

• Cut (4) 1" x 14½" rectangles, (8) 1" x 12" rectangles, (4) 1" x 8" rectangles, and (4) 1" x 4" rectangles.

9. 23032 H:

• Cut (4) 2½" squares, (5) 1" x 14½" rectangles, Cut (2) 1" x 59" rectangles from one of the SELVAGE EDGES as this will use the excess of the backing fabric (Sashing and Inner Border).

Block B - Make(2):

Note: Refer to the Finished Block as an additional guide.

- 17. Sew (1) 23032T 1" x 12" rectangle to the LEFT side of the ROTATED which was set aside from Instruction No. 11 Make (2) Set B.
- **18.** Sew (1) 23031E 2½" x 12" rectangle to (1) 23032T 1" x 12" rectangle Make (2) Set C.
- 19. Sew (1) of Set A (ROTATED) and Set B (ROTATED) together at the 12" edge with Set A towards the LEFT then sew on Set C to the BOTTOM to measure 12" x 14½".
- **20.** Sew (1) 23032H 2½" square to one 2½" edge of (1) 23031E 2½" x 12½" rectangle Make (2) then sew (1) 23032T 1" x 14½" rectangle to the right 14½" edge with the 2½" square towards the BOTTOM.
- 21. Sew the piece just completed to the left of the 12" x 14½" rectangle sewn in Instruction No. 19 to finish the block at 14½" square Make (2).

Block A – Make (2):

Note: Refer to the Finished Block as an additional guide.

- 10. Sew the following together at the 8" edge from top to bottom to measure 8" x 12": (1) 23027T 8" square, (1) 23032T 1" x 8" rectangle, (1) 23031E 4" x 8" rectangle as shown in Example A Make (4) set aside (2) for use in Block B Set A.
- 11. Sew the following together at the 4" edge from top to bottom to measure 4" x 12": (1) 23027S 4" x 8" rectangle, (1) 23032T 4" x 1" rectangle, (1) 23028X 4" square as shown in Example B Make (4) set aside (2) for use in Block B.
- **12.** Sew (1) 23032T 1" x 12" rectangle to the LEFT side of the rectangle just sewn Make (2) Set B.
- **13.** Sew (1) 23029S 2½" x 12" rectangle to (1) 23032T 1" x 12" rectangle Make (2) Set C.
- **14.** Sew (1) of Set A and Set B together at the 12" edge with Set A towards the LEFT then sew on Set C to the FAR LEFT to measure $14\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12".
- **15.** Sew (1) 23032H 2½" square to one 2-1/2" edge of (1) 23031E 2½" x 12½" rectangle Make (2) then sew (1) 23032T 1" x 14½" rectangle to the bottom 14½" edge with the 2½" square towards the LEFT.
- 16. Sew the piece just completed to the top of the $14\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12" rectangle sewn in Instruction No. 14 to finish the block at $14\frac{1}{2}$ " square Make (2).

Sewing the Tablerunner Center and Borders:

Note: Refer to the cover picture as an additional guide.

- **22.** Sew the center together as follows from left to right to measure 14½" x 59": 23032H 1" x 14½", Block A, 23032H 1" x 14½", Block B, 23032H 1" x 14½", Block B ROTATED TWICE, 23032H 1" x 14-½", Block A ROTATED TWICE, 23032H 1" x 14-½".
- 23. Sew (1) 23032H 1" x 59" rectangle to the top and bottom to finish the center along with the Inner Border at 15½" x 59".
- 24. Using the 23031T 3½" strips sew them together at the 3½" edge to make a long strip then sub-cut into (2) 3½" x 15½" rectangles (Sides) and (2) 3½" x 59" rectangles (Top/Bottom).
- **25.** Sew on the Top and Bottom to the Tablerunner.
- 26. Sew (1) 23031E 3½" squares to each 3½" edge of the 23031T 3½" x 15½" rectangles to measure 3½" x 21" Make (2) then sew onto each side to finish the Tablerunner at 21" x 64½".

Finishing the Table Runner:

- **27.** Layer the "Tins" 23031H backing, batting and Tablerunner top and quilt as desired.
- **28.** Using the 23030A 2½" strips sew on the binding to finish the Tablerunner.

Rotary Cutter, Mat, Rulers, Straight Pins, Sewing Machine, and threads to match your fabrics

Cutting Directions:

1. 23027 S:

- Cut (4) 8" x 4" rectangles.
- 1. 23026 A: Fussy Cut as follows:
- Jars (2) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (Front),
- Tins (2) $18\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (Back).

2. 23029 H:

• Cut (4) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

3. 23031 E:

• Cut (4) 5" x 8½" rectangles.

4. 23032 A: Cut as follows:

- (4) 1" x 18½" rectangles,
- (4) 1" x 8½" rectangles, and
- (2) 1" x 20½" rectangles.

5. 23032 H:

• Cut (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.

6. 23032 T:

• Cut (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.

7. 23030 ES:

• Cut (4) strips at 2½" x **WOF** (Binding)

Just A Pinch Placemats



Sewing the Placemat Front:

- 8. Sew the following together from left to right at the 8½" edge to make the center of the placemat at 18½" x 8½" ---- (1) 23031E 5" x 8½" rectangle, (1) 23032A 1" x 8½" rectangle, Jars 8½" square, (1) 23032A 1" x 8½" rectangle, (1) 23031E 5" x 8½" rectangle Make (2) as shown in Example A.
- **9.** Sew (1) 23032A 1" x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top and bottom to measure $18\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Make (2).
- **10.** Sew the following together from left to right to make a new strip at 5½" x 20½" ----- (1) 23032H 2½", (1) 23032A 1", (1) 23032T 2½", (1) 23032A 1" Sub-cut into (8) 5½" x 2½" rectangles.
- 11. Sew (1) of the rectangles just completed to each $2\frac{1}{2}$ " edge of (1) 23029H $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to make a new rectangle at 18-1/2" x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Make (2) as shown in Example B.
- 12. Sew (1) of the rectangles just completed to the top and bottom of the rectangle sewn in Instruction No. 9 to finish the FRONT of the placemat at 18½" x 13½" Make (2).

Finishing the Placemats:

- **13.** Layer the "Tins" #23026A backing, batting and quilt top and quilt as desired.
- **14.** Using the 23030ES $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips sew on the binding to finish the placemats.
