





Cutting Directions:

From (A) Main Panel (23433 Q): Label each strip as you cut

- Fussy cut one $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $29\frac{1}{2}$ " strip (A-1). Charaters **Holding Hands**
- Fussy cut one 12½" x 16½" strip (A-2). Bear Block 2
- Fussy cut one $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strip (A-3). Tracks Block 3
- Fussy cut one 10½" x 11½" strip (A-4). Turtle Block 1
- Fussy cut one $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $17\frac{1}{2}$ " strip (A-5). Hedgehog –
- Fussy cut one 81/4" x 121/2" strip (A-6). Fox Block 4

From (B) Blue Swirls (23437 Q): Label each set of strips as you cut

- Cut three 1" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two 1" x 54½" strips.
- Cut three 1" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two 1" x 47½" strips.
- Cut five 1½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strip into two

- $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " strips Turtle; two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{4}$ " strips Fox; two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strips Tracks; two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strips Tracks; two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " strips Bear; and, two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
- Cut two 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 2" x 12½" strips Turtle and Hedgehog.
- Cut one 2½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and two $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " strips Fox.
- Cut one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " strips Hedgehog.
- Cut six 2½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From (C) White Tracks (23436 Z):

• Cut one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x **WOF** strip. Sub-cut the strip into six $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From (D) Tan Dots (23438 A):

• Cut two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x **WOF** strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-six $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.



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From (E) Clouds (23435 Z):

• Cut one $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x **WOF** strip. Sub-cut the strip into three $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares.

From (F) Yellow Dots (23438 S):

- Cut one $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x **WOF** strip. Sub-cut the strip into three $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares.
- Cut one $3\frac{1}{8}$ " x **WOF** strip. Sub-cut the strip into two $3\frac{1}{8}$ " squares and four $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Cut two 2½" x **WOF** strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-three 2½" squares.

From (G) Blue Dots (23438Q):

- Cut one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.
- Cut two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut three 2½" x **WOF** strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two 2½" x 50½" strips.
- Cut three $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x **WOF** strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $46\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut five $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from the remaining fabric.

From (H) White Swirls (23437 ZK):

- Cut one 3%" x **WOF** strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 3%" squares and eight $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Cut one $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x **WOF** strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $2\frac{1}{8}$ " squares and three $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From (I) Tan Swirls (23437 A):

- Cut one $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x **WOF** strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and three $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Cut one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x **WOF** strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From (J) Gray Dots (23438 K):

• Cut one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x **WOF** strip. Sub-cut the strip into six $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From (K) Tan Tracks (23436 A):

• Cut one $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x **WOF** strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and five $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From (L) Blue Characters (23434 Q):

• Cut one $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x **WOF** strip. Sub-cut the strip into one $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square and two $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From (M) Yellow Characters (23434 S):

• Cut six 4½" x **WOF** strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut four 4½" x 55½" strips.

From Blue Dots (23438 Q) for the backing:

• Cut two 63" x **WOF** strips. Sew the strips together and cut one 63" x 71" piece for the backing.

Blocks:

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- 1. Sew one 1½" x 11½" Fabric B strip to each side of one 10½" x 11½" Fabric A strip (A-4). Sew one 2" x 12½" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the 10½" x 11½" Fabric A strip to complete Block One Turtle.
- 2. Sew 1½" x 16½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 12½" x 16½" Fabric A strip (A-2). Sew one 1½" x 14½" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the 12½" x 16½" Fabric A strip to make one Block Two Bear.
- **3.** Sew one 1½" x 10½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 6½" x 10½" Fabric A strip (A-3). Sew one 1½" x 8½" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the 6½" x 10½" Fabric A strip to complete one Block Three Tracks.
- **4.** Sew one 1½" x 8½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 8½" x 12½" Fabric A strip (A-6). Sew one 1½" x 14½" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the 8½" x 12½" Fabric A strip to complete Block Four Fox.
- **5.** Sew one 2" x 12½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 12½" x 17½" Fabric A strip (A-5). Sew one 2½" x 20½" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the 12½" x 17½" Fabric A strip to complete Block Five Hedgehog.
- **6.** Place one 37/8" Fabric F square on top of one 37/8" Fabric H square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make two F/H units (Fig. 3). Trim blocks to measure 31/2" square. Repeat to make four F/H units total.

7. Place one 3½" Fabric H square on the left side of one 3½" x 6½" Fabric K strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 5). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.







8. Place another 3½" Fabric H square on the right side of the 3½" x 6½" Fabric K strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to complete one H/K/H unit.

- **9.** Repeat Steps 7-8 to make four H/K/H units total.
- 10. Place one 3½" Fabric F square on the top left corner of one 6½" Fabric L square, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 9). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ½" away from the sewn seam.

11. Follow Figure 10 for the seam direction to add a 3½" Fabric F square to each of the remaining corners of the 6½" Fabric L square to make one F/L unit (Fig. 11).

12. Follow Figure 12 and sew four F/H units, four H/K/H units and one F/L unit together to make one Block Six. Trim to 12½" square.



13. Repeat Step 6 using four $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric H squares and four $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric I squares to make eight $2\frac{1}{2}$ " H/I units (Fig. 13).

14. Repeat Steps 7-8 using eight 2½" x 4½" Fabric I strips and sixteen 2½" Fabric F squares to make eight F/I/F units total (Fig. 14).

15. Follow Figure 15 and sew four H/I units, four F/I/F units and one 4½" Fabric L square together to make one Block Seven. Repeat to make a second Block Seven. Trim to 8½"



16. Repeat Steps 10-11 using six 4½" Fabric C squares and twenty-four 2½" Fabric D squares to make six C/D units (Fig. 16).

- 17. Repeat Step 6 with three 51/4" Fabric E squares and three 51/4" Fabric F squares, to make six E/F half-square triangles. Trim the blocks to measure 47/8" square.
- **18.** Place one half-square triangle from Step 17 on top of another half-square triangle, right sides together. Make sure the center seam is going in the same direction on both half-square triangles and the Fabric E Triangle in the top block is opposite from the F in the bottom block (Fig. 17).




19. Draw a diagonal line across the top half-square triangle so that it goes through the sewn seam. Sew ½" away from both sides of the drawn line (Fig. 18). Cut on the drawn line to make two F/E units (Fig. 19).



20. Repeat Steps 18-19 to make six F/E units total.

Assembling the Quilt Top: Refer to the quilt layout while assembling (on page 6)


- 21. Sew one 12½" x 29½" Fabric A strip (A-1), one 1½" x 12½" Fabric G strip and the Block Six together to make Row One.
- **22.** Refer to the quilt layout to sew together nine assorted 2½" squares to make one 9-block Sashing Row. Repeat to make a second 9-block sashing row.
- 23. Refer to the quilt layout to sew together six assorted $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to make one 6-block sashing row.
- **24.** Refer to the quilt layout to sew together seven assorted 2½" squares to make one 7-block sashing row.
- **25.** Sew together Block One, Block Two, Block Three, five C/D units, four F/E units, two 9-block sashing rows and one 6-block sashing row to make Row Two.
- **26.** Sew together Block Four, Block Five, two Block Sevens, one C/D unit, two F/E units, one 2½" Fabric K square, one 2½" Fabric J square and one 7-block sashing row to make Row Three.
- 27. Sew the three rows, in numerical order, and two 2½" x 42½" Fabric G strips together, alternating them, to make the quilt top.
- **28.** Sew one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $46\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- **29.** Sew one 1" x $54\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1" x $47\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- **30.** Sew one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $55\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $55\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.



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Finishing:

- **31.** Layer and quilt as desired.
- **32.** Sew the six 2½" x **WOF** Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- **33.** Bind as desired.
